EOSF Cookie Policy

The EOSF website ("Website") uses cookies to distinguish you as a user, either for the duration of your visit ("session cookie") or when you return ("persistent cookie"). Cookies are small files stored on your browser or the hard drive of your computer that are used to gather information regarding interactions with the Website such as browser type, operating systems, IP address, device type, location, date and time of access. - Behavioural advertising cookies that tailor advertising served to you on the Website based on your browsing activity and the location from which you access the Website.

We use first party cookies to enable users to remain signed in and to ensure that our Cookie Policy notification is effective for all users of the service.

Examples of third party cookies we may use:

- Google Analytics, to be able to measure traffic and performance of the service;
- Google (Double Click for Publishers), to be able to provide advertising of products or services that reflect your use of the service;
- Social sharing widgets, to enable you to share content with a range of networking and sharing platforms and for us to be able to see how often content has been shared;
- Video Players, to enable video player functionality and allow reporting, analytics, and monitoring on usage to improve the player experience; and
- Google or Facebook, to enable you to sign in using your Google or Facebook account.
