Terms and Conditions:

- 1. Setup / Breakdown:** All exhibitors must be set up and ready to sell by 10:00 am, the day of the festival. Exhibitors may begin setting up at 8:00 am, the day of the festival. Breakdown can start no sooner than 4:00 pm on Sunday and must be completed by 7:00 pm, unless approval by Staff. No vendor is to close before the official closing time. Or subject to penalties. Sellers are responsible for their own selling space. *Before leaving be sure your area is clean and trash free.
- 2. Staffing:** Exhibitor tables/booths must be always staffed and intact until the show closes at 4 pm. The Wilson Lions are not responsible for merchandise or display materials.
- 3. Exhibitor Items:** Items for sale at the Exhibitors booth must be predominantly handmade by the Exhibitor. Each exhibitor must submit a few photographs of his/her craft(s). If participating as a crafter, Wilson Lions reserves the right to have items removed that are considered not appropriately handmade. **Items cannot be simply purchased for resale.**
- 4. Exhibitor Responsibility:** Exhibitor will be responsible for any loss or damage to his or her property by theft, fire or casualty. The Wilson Lions, Wilson Historical Society expressly denies any responsibility for same. Exhibitors shall be responsible for any damage which may be incurred to the facilities as a result or in connection with their operation. Each Exhibitor is responsible for the conduct of his employees and/or representatives and activities must not detract from the image or welfare of the festival.
- 5. Exhibitor Spaces:** Exhibitor spaces will be assigned. Placement, flow and competition will be taken into consideration to provide the best experience for Festival attendees. If you have special space needs, please include your request with your application and we will make every effort to accommodate you. Spaces are reserved on a first come first served basis. Vendors must ensure that none of their display equipment extends beyond the space they have booked this includes any rails, stands or additional equipment.
- 6. One business per table:** Only one (1) business per table; space may not be sublet or shared without prior approval by an authorized staff of the Wilson Lions.
- 7. Acceptance:** The Wilson Lions reserves the right to decline any application for space, if it deems such an action to be in the best interest of the Annual Homemade Arts & Crafts Festival.
- 8. Payment:** The full payment is a non-refundable registration fee for the selected space and is due with the submission of this agreement. This fee will be used to cover advertising and other incidental costs associated with the production of this event.
- 9. Electricity / Internet:** Electricity will not be available. No Internet service is provided by this festival extension cords are not included in the fee and must be provided by the Exhibitor.
- 10. Music:** Festival Music may be provided. If an Exhibitor has music in their space, it will not interfere with businesses in adjoining spaces
- 11. Tables and Chairs:** Each Exhibitor must furnish his or her own chairs, tables, stands, tents or canopy.

Terms and Conditions (cont.):

12. **Outdoor Exhibitors:** For outside Exhibitors, it is advised to bring along shims, or blocks of wood to level out tables, since most of the areas are flat unlevel ground. All tents and canopies must be secured to the ground using weights/sandbags in case of windy weather.
13. **Cancellation of space:** Application fees are not refundable. Wilson Lions is not liable if weather or other conditions prevent the Exhibitor from attending and fulfilling the contractual obligation as an Exhibitor. No refunds will be made for weather, accident, health, or other causes for non-participation.
14. **Indemnification:** Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Wilson Lions Club and Wilson Historical Society from any loss, expense, claims, damages, causes of action, injuries, suits or damages, suits to person or property, including attorney's fees, arising out of or related to the operation of the Exhibitors at the Wilson Homemade Arts & Crafts Festival.

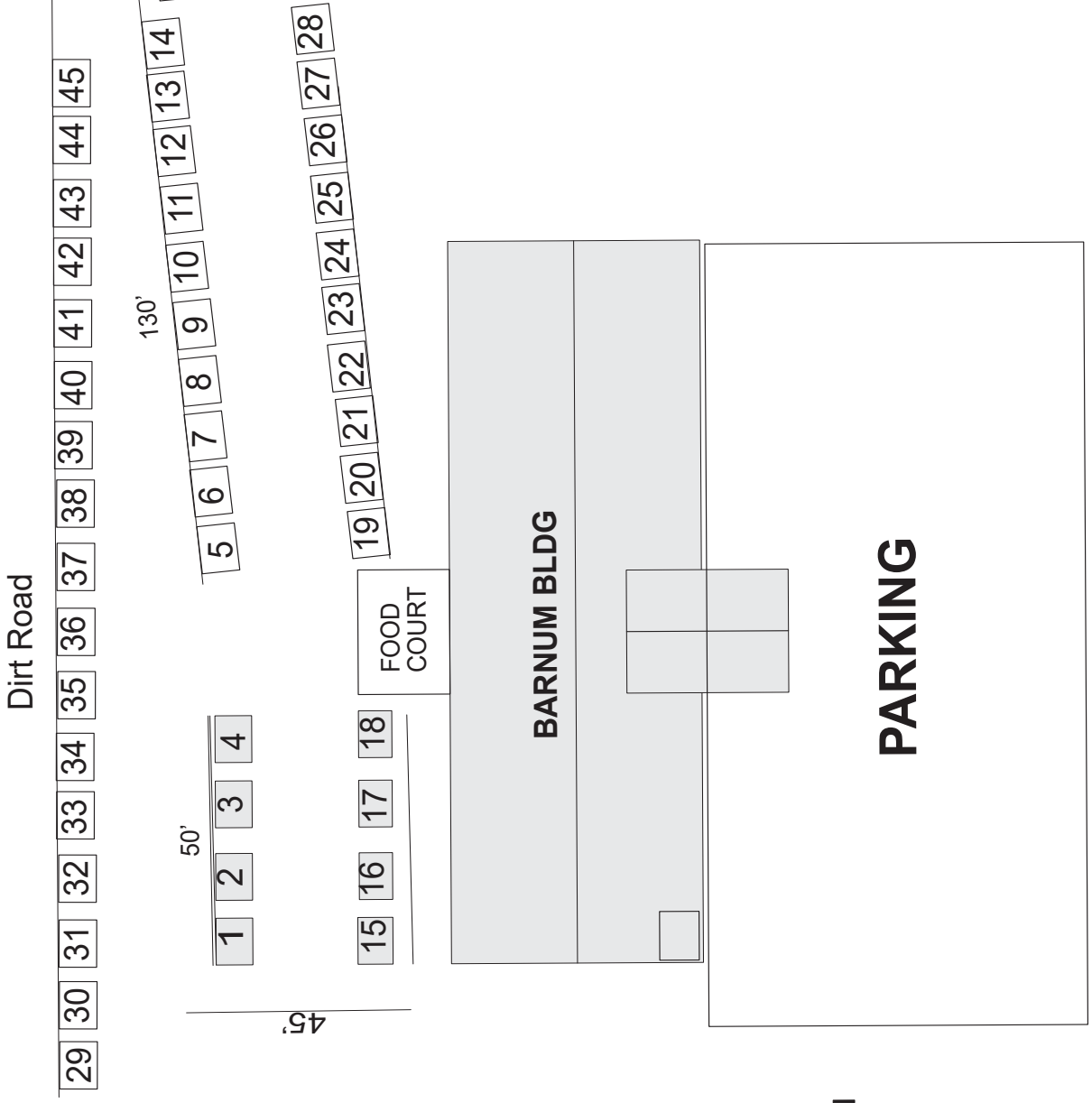
