Zonta Women in Business Leadership Award

Zonta celebrates women who demonstrate exceptional leadership and entrepreneurial spirit, offering 10 international awards of US\$10,000 each and a complimentary one-year supporting membership in Zonta International for the next financial year.

Deadline: Club application to D3 by September 15, 2025

Zonta Young Women in Leadership Award

Zonta recognizes young women for demonstrating leadership skills and commitment to public service with up to 37 awards of US\$5,000 each annually.

D3 Deadline April 1, 2026

Zonta Women in Stem Award

Offering up to 16 awards of US\$10,000 and a complimentary one-year supporting membership in Zonta International for the next financial year.

TBA 2025, 2026

Deadline: Club application to D3 by December 1, 2025

Amelia Earhart Fellowship

Zonta annually awards up to 30 Fellowships of US\$10,000 each to women pursuing Ph.D./doctoral degrees in aerospace engineering and space sciences.

CLIMATE EMPOWER: COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT AND INNOVATION FOR GENDER-TRANSFORMATIVE CLIMATE ACTION



Funding: US\$1,000,000



Climate change impacts women and girls and their sexual and reproductive health and rights.

- Access to food, water, shelter and livelihoods is disrupted.
- Child marriage and intimate partner violence increases.



Goal: Prevent climate-induced gender based-violence (GBV) and other harmful practices through interwoven innovative approaches and community-driven interventions in Madagascar, Mozambique and South Sudan.



Approximately 500,000 direct and indirect beneficiaries will be equipped with knowledge of the impacts of climate change and trained to identify and initiate solutions to build resilience against climate-induced GBV.



LAAHA: A VIRTUAL SAFE SPACE FOR WOMEN AND GIRLS



Funding: US\$750,000



1 in 3 women experience violence in their lifetime and 12 million girls are married before they reach the age of 18 – violence that is exponentially made worse during humanitarian crises.



Goal: Increase knowledge on GBV and sexual and reproductive health and reduce isolation by building safe spheres of support through peer-to-peer connection.



Reach one million women and girls across the world with content created in 20 languages by 2026.

ENDING CHILD MARRIAGE: A PROGRAMME TO ACCELERATE GLOBAL ACTION PHASE III



Funding: US\$1,500,000



Globally, 21% of girls are married while they are still children, robbing them of their childhood.



Goal: Scale up the Global Programme's activities to protect and empower girls, and ultimately help bring an end to the practice of child marriage.



The program's priority is engaging adolescent girls as key agents of change in 12 countries which account for almost half of the world's child marriage.

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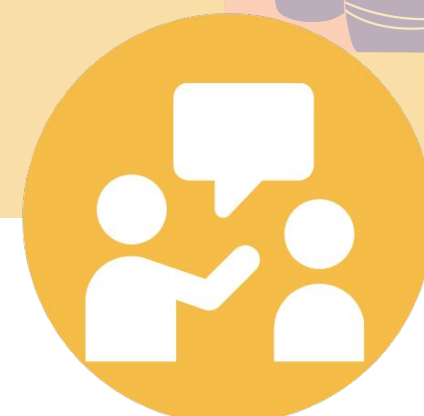
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
