



Youth Minister Role Purpose

The Part-Time Youth Minister will lead a relational, Christ-centered youth ministry for students in grades 6–12 that encourages them to know Jesus, grow in faith, and actively participate in the life and mission of the church. This role prioritizes discipleship, spiritual growth, leadership development, and meaningful relationships over heavy programming or administrative workload.

Time & Structure

- Part-time position with flexible weekly hours
- Primary responsibilities occur during evenings and weekends
- Limited administrative duties to allow focus on direct ministry with students and leaders
- Works collaboratively with the Pastor and church staff

Primary Responsibilities

Discipleship and Teaching

- Lead regular youth gatherings (weekly classes, Bible study, group meetings)
- Teach Scripture clearly and practically in an age-appropriate, engaging manner
- Establish consistent discipleship rhythms that emphasize spiritual maturity and life application

Relational Ministry

- Build meaningful, safe, and appropriate relationships with students and families
- Foster a welcoming, gospel-centered environment where students feel known, valued, and connected
- Model godly character and maintain healthy boundaries and church safety policies

Leadership Development

- Recruit, train, and support adult volunteers and student leaders
- Develop student leaders to assist with teaching, service, and group leadership

Programming, Fellowship and Outreach

- Plan engaging and relevant activities that support discipleship and community
- Organize key events such as an annual summer camp and family mission trip
- Encourage participation in local service and mission opportunities in partnership with church ministries

Church and Parent Partnership

- Communicate consistently with parents as partners in discipleship
- Collaborate with other church ministries to integrate youth into the broader church life
- Assist the Pastor as requested in support of the church's mission

Administration and Stewardship

- Plan and manage the youth ministry budget responsibly
- Utilize basic technology, multimedia, and social media tools safely and effectively
