PRESIDENTS REPORT



Cubby House member, Shai Thaler sent me the following note which he wanted me to share with you:

“I finally finished my project. I have a CNC lathe in my garage. The machine body is an old Austrian CNC lathe that my former boss wanted to get rid of. I stripped it from all its elements and replaced the ball screws (a type of leadscrew that eliminates backlash) and motors for length and cross slides. Put a chuck on it and a main motor for spinning the chuck.

Motors are very cheap for DIY purposes and software for driving the machine is free downloaded from the internet. With help from a friend who is an electrical engineer we got the machine working. It is capable of machining metal but I use it to do wood only. It works on the same principle that the CNC router we have in house does.

Anyone interested in seeing it are invited for a demo, and I will also gladly make items for cubby house members, or for toys.”

So, if any member would like to take up Shai’s offer, please contact him or myself.

There is no further information in regards to the proposed Masterplan Design for the Oyster Bay Oval which includes the Cubby House clubhouse. We will be looking to have discussions with the Council over the coming months.

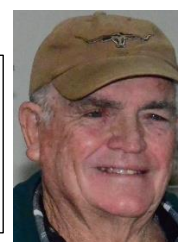

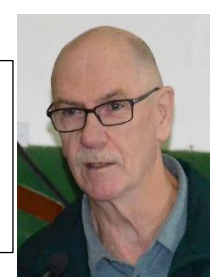
