  - CNC Laser Cutter – Frank reported that the water cooler for one of the lamps appears to malfunctioning. This is despite the fact that the water appears to be flowing OK. It could be a circuit board issue but it was decided not call the specialist electrician but replace the water cooler. The cost will be around \$900 and the committee authorised the expenditure
  - CNC Router – The computer program for the router has now been uploaded to the Cubby House computer. It was considered the original version of the program was adequate and particularly as a new version would cost around \$1,500. The committee authorised the expenditure of up to \$300 to purchase new cutting bits to expand the jobs that the router can perform

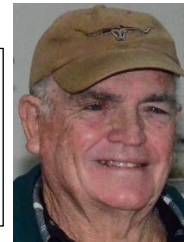

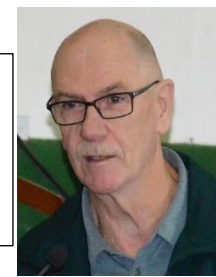
