1 **Meeting opened** by the President at 10:05.

3 **Minutes** of the Committee Meeting dated 13th May 2024, as circulated previously, discussed and confirmed (Moved David Coles, Seconded Alan Pentecost).

Business Arising – Secretary successfully rostered 14 volunteers across the Oyster Bay Art & Craft Festival on Sat 25 & Sun 26/05/2024 (Complete). Secretary advertised the Private Equipment of a deceased estate 'For Sale' in the May Newsletter (Complete). The annual 'Electrical Tagging and Testing' is due in July and is to be allocated to one of two electricians (existing members) in due course (Incomplete).

5 **Reports:**

President – see written report in Newsletter.

Secretary – Nil.

Treasurer – May Income of \$4,483.18; less Outgoings of \$502.25 = \$3,980.93 for the month. The majority of the income relates to the Oyster Bay Art & Craft Festival (\$1486.55 gross) and early Membership Fees. Consequently, we have now returned to a positive position overall when considered as 'year to date'.

6 **General Business:**

- June Maxi Day – Sat 15 June – Theme is 'Jigs'. Host is Malcolm Stewart. Anyone with a 'jig' to share is encouraged to demonstrate alongside Malcolm.

- Car Park Bollards – the current design is problematic, with the padlocks being adversely affected by the weather. Consequently, President Phil has taken issue with the Council re same. We await their response.
- Toy Week Tue 11th to Fri 14th June – toy production remains an important part of the Club's identity and all members are encouraged to help wherever possible (with this one or the next).
- Change of Bank Account – we wait patiently for 'next steps' as all paperwork is currently being assessed by Westpac.
- SSC Oyster Bay draft Masterplan (working group) – Nil to report. It is rumoured that Council has progressed the matter but we have not had any communication, so, President Phil is going to follow-up with them to get an official position.
 - **ACTION ITEM:** President Phil to email Council.
- Safety Induction Program (working group) – training / certification efforts by Alan Pentecost for all members continue. It is in every member's interest to seek Alan out re same as there will soon come a time whereby members who are not certified on individual items of equipment will NOT be permitted to use them!
The Club now has a documented Induction Program for new members; which is to be shared across all existing members likewise.
 - **ACTION ITEM:** Secretary to circulate booklet to all members.
The sub-committee will soon meet to progress and/or finalise all outstanding aspects of the program.
 - **ACTION ITEM:** Sub-committee to meet re same.
- Oyster Bay Art & Craft Festival –stall for Sat 25 & Sun 26/05/2024 was a great success. We sold 128 individual items for a gross income of \$1,486.55 and the stall was excellent for raising our profile in the local community. Big thanks go to the 14 volunteers that helped out across the weekend!
- Maxi Day Demonstrators – Hosts are required (volunteers please) for the August, September and October meetings. Anyone interested, please see Secretary Simon or President Phil.
- Welfare Contacts – see Keith Moses for details; they are deliberately left out of the minutes for member's confidentiality.
- ATO Self Reporting Obligations – is an annual process, due 31/10/2024. Treasurer Steve has the lead and explained (in broad terms) the implications to those present. It is a significant body of work that may require an update of the constitution at the August AGM. The Executive Committee will work through it all and report back in due course.
