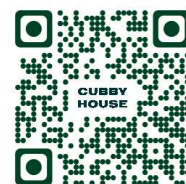

A last reminder that the membership renewal fee is now overdue. The membership covers insurance so if you are not a financial member you will not be able to use or operate the club's equipment.

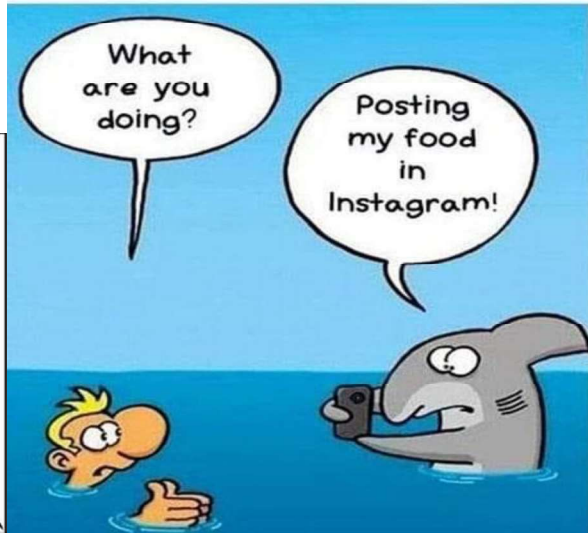
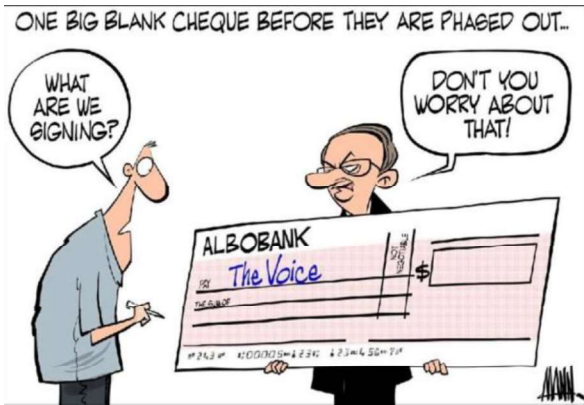
Upcoming events:
