

BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES

June 23, 2026 – Denton Community Center

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Denton, Nebraska, was held at the Denton Community Center on June 23, 2026. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. All proceedings were conducted in open session and were open to attendance by the public.

Board Members Present: Amanda Fangmeier, Joe Hobelman, Doug Rosekrans Trent Wheatley and Ryan Osborn. Hobelman stated that the Nebraska Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall and available for public inspection.

Notice of this meeting was publicly posted prior to the meeting at the Denton Daily Double, the Denton Post Office, and the Denton Community Center, as required by law.

1. Public Comment. Members of the public wishing to present to the Village Board on any matter of public interest will be invited to do so during this segment of the meeting. Each presenter will be limited to a maximum of three minutes of speaking time. Gail Braunsroth thanked all the volunteers for Denton Daze. Lona Anderson requested clarification regarding the Open Meetings Act, meeting procedures, and how the June 15 meeting was conducted. She stated that she was not permitted to speak during the meeting, while six other individuals were allowed to speak afterward. She expressed her desire for all citizens to be treated fairly and stated that a previous request to amend the zoning ordinance was not acknowledged.

2. Resolution 2026-6-23 Certifying a Date for a Recall Election of Trustee; Discussion and Possible Action. Fangmeier motioned seconded by Roskrans to pass and approve Resolution 26-6-23. Carried.

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-6-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DENTON, NEBRASKA, AUTHORIZING, ORDERING, AND CERTIFYING A DATE FOR A RECALL ELECTION OF TRUSTEE AMANDA FANGMEIER

WHEREAS, a recall petition was filed with the Election Commissioner of Lancaster County, Nebraska, requesting the recall of Amanda Fangmeier, member of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Denton, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, according to a letter received from the Lancaster County Election Commissioner, Lancaster County, Nebraska on June 10, 2026, the petition verification process was concluded and the number of valid signatures required by law was sufficient in number to proceed to a recall election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §32-1306, the Governing Body of the Village of Denton, Nebraska shall, within twenty-one (21) days after receipt of notification from the filing clerk, order an election on the first available date that complies with Neb. Rev. Stat. §32-405 and that can be certified to the Lancaster County Election Commissioner at least fifty (50) days prior to the election.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Denton, Nebraska, that pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §32-1306, the Governing Body of the Village of Denton does hereby order a recall election of Amanda Fangmeier, member of the Board of Trustees, to be held on Tuesday, November 10, 2026 in conjunction with the Statewide General Election.

PASSED AND APPROVED this 23 day of June, 2026.

3. Action Regarding Payment of Accrued Vacation Leave Upon Employee Separation; Discussion and Possible Action. Motioned by Fangmeier seconded by Rosekrans to agree to payout Ross Blackledge's remaining vacation hours of 153.85 in one payout in the current payperiod. Carried.

4. Temporary Pickleball Setup Discussion. TeBrink stated that she will purchase pickleball court marking tape and a net strap to set up a temporary pickleball court for the summer to evaluate community use. The estimated cost of the supplies is approximately \$125, which will be submitted for reimbursement.

5. 2026 Zoning Book Handout. The books have arrived.

6. Adjournment.
