Motioned by Roserkans and seconded by Wheatley to approve the meeting minutes from the May 6, 2024 meeting. Carried.

- a. Roof Repair Insurance Claim from Storm Damage. Blackledge has met with the insurance adjuster and contractors for assessments and bids. Juricek motioned to approve the bids from Golden Rule Contracting to repair all the damaged roofs along with patching and recoating the well house. Rosekrans seconded. Carried.
- b. Asphalt Repair and Crack Sealing Bids Discussion. Blackledge reviewed bids with the board. Juricek motioned to authorize Chair Hobelman to sign a contract with APMS Asphalt for the agreed price of \$3,200 for asphalt milling and replacement .63 cents a linear foot for crack sealing. Fangmeier seconded. Carried.

- d. Public Hearing for Fireworks Sales in R1 Zoning. At 7:00 pm, Juricek motioned, seconded by Fangmeier, to open a public hearing to hear comments on a conditional use permit for a retail fireworks stand at 7105 Cass Ave. Carried. At 7:03 p.m. Juricek motioned to close the public hearing. Fangmeier seconded. Carried. Juricek motioned, seconded by Rosekrans, to approve a conditional permit for retail fireworks sales at 7105 Cass Ave. Unanimous.

- e. Special Event Permit for June 28th. Juricek motioned, seconded by Roskrans, to approve the Special Events permit for Saturday, June 29th, for a town celebration sponsored by the Denton Community Historical Society. Carried.
- **f. Trustee Election** Incumbent filing deadline 7/15/24 and nonicumbent filing deadline 8/1/24. Three seats are up for election in November of 2024.
- g. Approval to purchase more cornhole game boards. Juricek motioned to approve the purchase of four more Cornhole board sets at \$120 per set. Wheatly seconded. Carried.
- h. Investments. Rosekrans motioned, seconded by Juricek, to approve the following purchase of CDs from LPL Investments: \$500,000 2 years and \$178,000 in 18 months. Carried.
- i. July meeting Date. Motioned by Fangmeier, seconded by Wheatley to schedule the regular Village Board of Trustees meeting to Monday, July 8th. Carried.
