

BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES

June 1, 2026 – Denton Community Center

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Denton, Nebraska, was held at the Denton Community Center on June 1, 2026. The meeting was called to order at 6:33 p.m. All proceedings were conducted in open session and were open to attendance by the public.

Board Members Present: Amanda Fangmeier, Doug Rosekrans Trent Wheatley and Ryan Osborn. Joe Hobelman was absent from the meeting. *Motion by Rosekrans seconded by Osborn to appoint Amanda Fangmeier as chairpro tem. Carried.* Fangmeier stated that the Nebraska Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall and available for public inspection.

Notice of this meeting was publicly posted prior to the meeting at the Denton Daily Double, the Denton Post Office, and the Denton Community Center, as required by law.

1. Approval of Minutes

Motion by Rosekrans, seconded by Wheatley, to approve the May 4 and May 21, 2026, meeting minutes. Carried.

2. Reports

a. Treasurer's Report. General \$5,969.16; Water \$36,522.18; Sewer \$2,815.18; Streets \$27,695.39; Community Center \$838.72

3. Maintenance Report. Jake Baker stated he sprayed the lagoons and we have been keeping up.

Mary Sue Wagoner expressed concerns about baseballs frequently entering their property from the nearby ball field and requested that the Village further investigate potential solutions. Fangmeier stated that she would reach out to Melissa Dittmer regarding the matter.


Lona Anderson thanked the Board for removing the tree located at W. Denton Avenue and Cass Avenue. She also requested that the Board consider increasing the minimum

8. Contract with City of Crete for Licensed Operator; discussion and possible action. Osborn moved, seconded by Wheatley, to approve the contract with the City of Crete for water and sewer services and to authorize Chair Joe Hobelman to execute the agreement on behalf of the Village. Motion carried.

9. Street Striping Bids Review; discussion/possible action. Three bids were received from separate striping companies for the proposed striping project. Discussion was held regarding the absence of formal specifications for street striping. Fangmeier suggested that the Village develop and adopt striping specifications for future projects. Following discussion, the matter was tabled until the next meeting.
