1. Emergency Medical Release

If medical care is necessary and I cannot be reached, I authorize Music and Play COS staff to act on my behalf in determining the best course of action for my child. This includes, but is not limited to, administering First Aid, CPR, calling emergency services, and hospitalizing if necessary.

I understand that all medical costs, including ambulance transport, are my responsibility. I agree to hold Music and Play COS harmless for any decisions made in my child's best interest and for any medical treatment provided by healthcare professionals.

2. Check-In & Check-Out

- Parents/guardians listed on your registration form are the only ones who may accompany campers in and out of the building for check-in and check-out daily.
- Campers will not be released to individuals not listed on the registration form.
- Location: 2120 Hollow Brook Drive
- Pick-up Time: Camp ends promptly at the specified time Sing, Play, Create I: 12PM Sing Play Create II, 3PM Play to Learn Piano: 3PM. Late pick-ups incur a \$20 fee per
 30 minutes, charged to your CC on file before the next camp day. Multiple late pick-ups
 may result in dismissal without a refund.

3. Absences & Tardiness

- No fee adjustments for late arrivals. Please text if running late.

4. Payment & Refunds

- Camp spots are secured only after payment is received.
- Parents who need to cancel their registration due to scheduling conflicts, sickness, or unforeseen circumstances will incur a \$50 cancellation fee, and must notify Music and Play COS within 30 days of the camp start date. Unused payments can be applied to other Music and Play COS services, including private/group lessons and classes, future camps or birthday parties and other events.

5. Cancellations

 Music and Play COS reserves the right to cancel camp if the minimum number of campers per camp is not met. Camps require a minimum of 7 students per camp.
 Parents will be notified 20 days in advance if there are less than 7 registered campers per camp. • *Refunds (minus the service fee) will only be processed in the event that the camp is cancelled.

6. Personal Belongings

- Label all belongings (bags, water bottles, lunchboxes, etc.).
- No personal instruments or toys unless requested by staff. Music and Play COS is not responsible for lost or damaged personal items.

7. Behavior & Participation Expectations

- Campers are expected to respect staff, peers, and instruments.
- If a camper is disruptive, staff will communicate with parents. Repeated or severe behavior issues may result in dismissal without a refund.

8. Dress Code & Supplies

- Comfortable, play-friendly clothing is required.
- Campers should bring a water bottle..
- No open-toed shoes for safety reasons.
- Campers need to bring their own snack from home.

9. Media Release

- Photos and videos may be taken during camp for **promotional use**.
- Names and information about campers will never be shared for promotional purposes.
