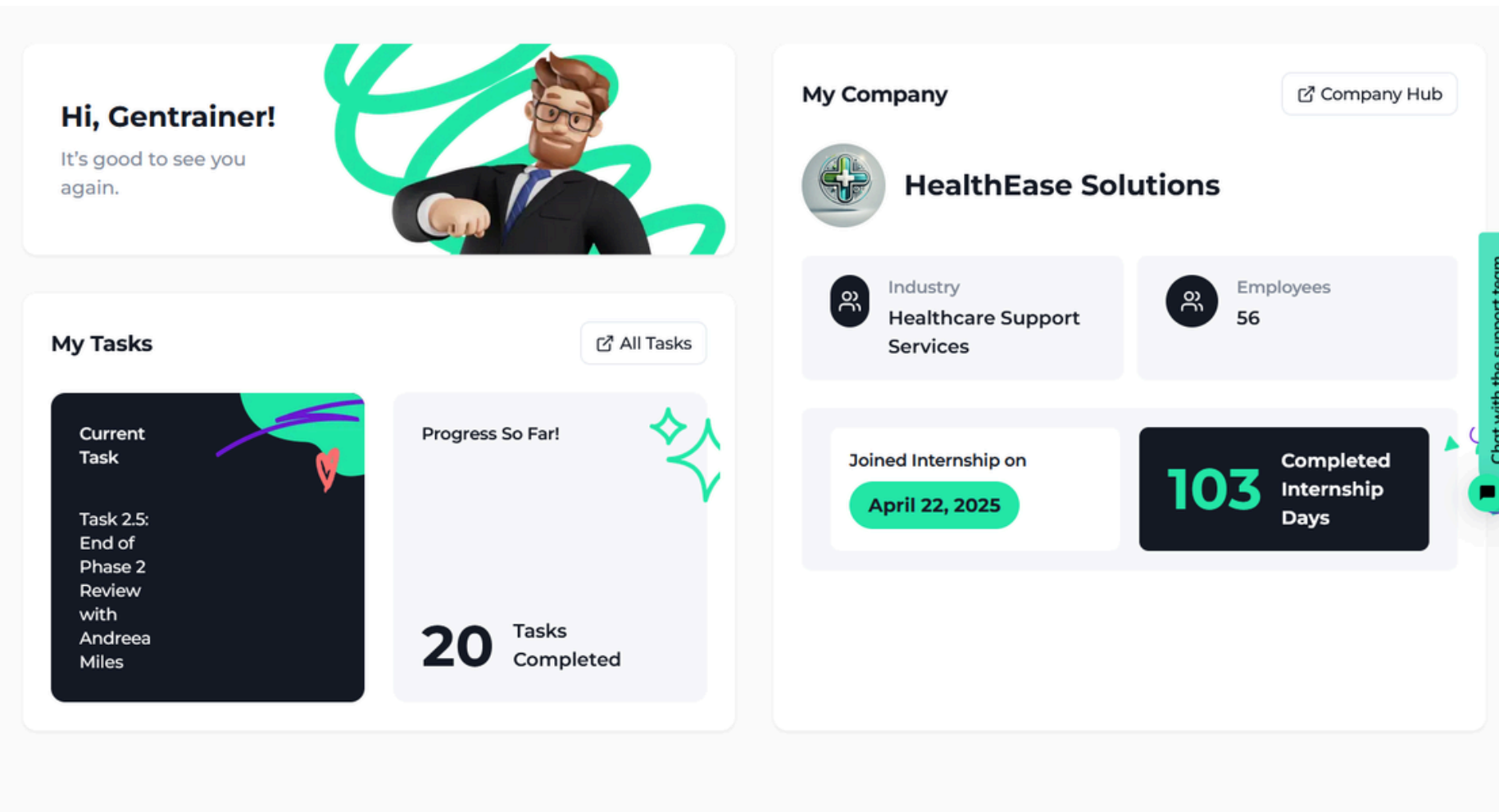
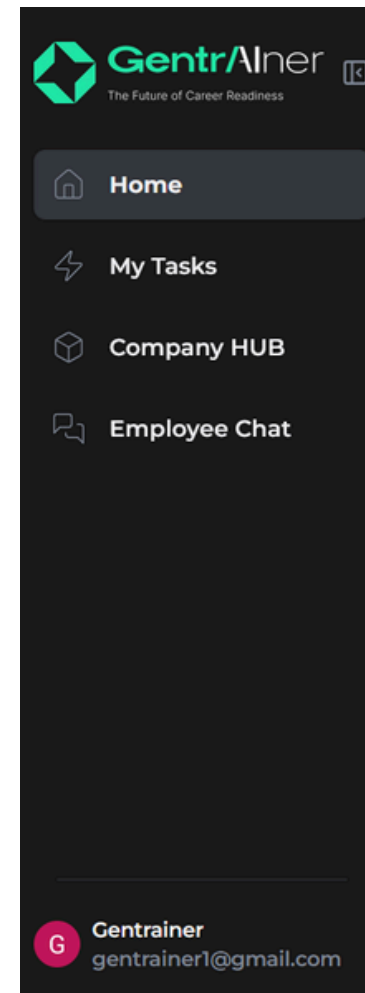
Gentrainer: By the Numbers

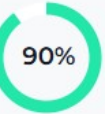

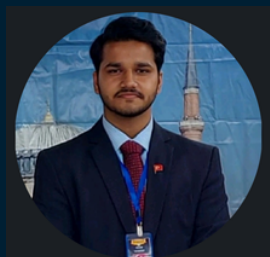
