

THE WAVE MACHINE

Caution! the liquids necessary to make THE WAVE MACHINE are dangerous if not handled and used properly. Therefore this project should be done with an adult to supervise. But don't let the warning discourage you from building THE WAVE MACHINE.

MATERIALS:


- Large transparent soft plastic bottle (disheswashing detergent or household cleaner bottle for example) with a screw top that fits tightly.
- Rubbing alcohol
- Blue food coloring
- Paint thinner

Construction:

Make sure not to use a glass bottle-the possibility of broken glass is to risky. Remove any labels from the bottle and rinse it out thoroughly. Fill the bottle about one-third filled with rubbing alcohol. Add the blue food coloring a drop at a time and shake gently until the alcohol is a nice "ocean blue". Fill the bottle the rest of the way to the top with paint thinner. tightly screw on the bottle cap. There should be no air at all inside the bottle.


MAKING WAVES:

Hold THE WAVE MACHINE on its side with both hands and gently rock the bottle back and forth to create the waves. You will soon develop the best rhythm for making gentle sea rolls or foamy crashing waves-the secret of THE WAVE MACHINE is that the alcohol and the paint thinner do not mix together (the food coloring mixes with the rubbing alcohol). Sometimes after a lot of rough use the liquids in the bottle will become cloudy. Put the WAVE MACHINE aside for a few hours and the liquids will become clear again.
