The time the CITs put my bed on the raft.



Clouds are big, white, and puffy.



After the three get together they decide to paint the town red. They go everywhere and come very close to getting caught in each place, but . . . of course they don't. They all get home safe.


The principal, who looks for Ferris through the whole movie, catches him sneaking in the house, but Ferris' sister saves him from trouble.
