Record location of manufacturer instructions, generic safety instructions and lift point information												
Check Accessibility and readability of warning labels												
Confirm adequacy of clearences around lift												
Examine all structural components including welds												
Examine electrical components and wiring												
Check lift controls and the integrity of tamper resistant seals of the pressure relief valves												
Check swing arm restraints and telescopic arm stops												
Check all fasteners and anchor bolts												
Operate the lift through full travel and observe, check the operation of the positive stop as well as the lifts locks												
Check all lift adapters condition and proper operation												
With a representative vehicle on the lift check the lowering speed, Stop the load at midpoint and observe												
Lubricate all points requiring lubrication (Cables, slider blocks, arm pins, sheaves, arm restraints etc.)												
Check synchronization of equalization system (locks should click simultaneously)												
Check all cables and chains including links and all terminations - Check the tracking and level winding												
Check all accessible piping, tubing, hose, valves and fittings												
Confirm cylinder venting provisions												
Confirm oil level adequacy at full height												
For runway style lifts, check to ensure proper operation of all features (wheel chocks, alignment pad locks, etc.)												
For Inground lifts confirm rotation prevention, check all trench covers & report the presence of liquid in any pit
