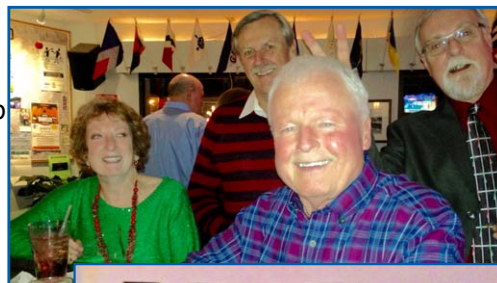
## Good Friends, Good Times and New Beginnings

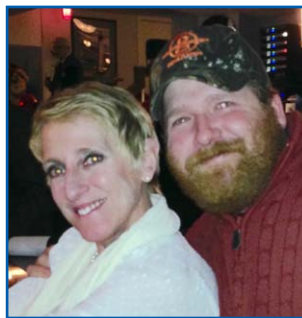

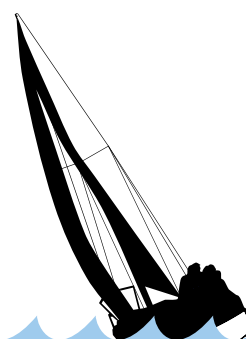
