- The YAK a Launcher™ is for the use of members and their guests only **EXCEPT** for times when the yacht club is open to the public. Example: Friday Nights and Harboritavilles, etc.
- Kayaks are launched and retrieved from the end of the boat dock. Carry your kayak to/from the end of the dock and do not interfere with the dinghies. Pull the kayak into the YAK a Launcher™ using a **BOW LINE**. When empty, your kayak can be pulled into the launcher from either side.
- You **MUST** use a bow line to tie the bow of your kayak to the YAK's handrail before entering or exiting your kayak.
  - You absolutely must **NOT** interfere with any dinghies parked at the dock. No entering, moving, blocking, etc.
  - Kayaks are not to be stored at the yacht club. Bring them for day and take them home.

- After dropping off your kayak, please park your car up on the street.
- If kayakers want to get out of their kayaks to enjoy Harboritaville or some other public event, they should exit their kayaks at the launcher, remove their kayak from the water at the end of the dock, and carry them up on the landing under the bridge. WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE KAYAKS OR ANY PERSONAL BELONGINGS LEFT IN THE KAYAKS while visiting. (We are investigating different methods of allowing the kayaks to tie up to the seawall without interfering with the dinghies using a Boat Hook.)

Guidelines have been approved by the Board of Directors.
