**Silver Needle**

### Iron Goddess Of Mercy

A smooth and creamy balled Oolong tea. Leaves are hand rolled in this semi oxidised tea.

### Taiwanese Oolong Poppy

This fine grade semi oxidised tea exudes beautiful woody and fruity flavours

### Shanghai Oolong Beets

This stunning blend of Sencha and Oolong tea combine with a hint of beetroot and raspberry for a fruity and earthy tartness.

### Gunpowder Green Tea

This tightly rolled green tea resembles pellets, hence its name. The taste is a slightly smoky and sweet and very drinkable.

### Lung Ching Dragonwell

A wonderful green tea from the Zhejiang province of China. Pan dried for a fresh, sweet flavour and creamy buttery notes.

### Hojicha Roasted Green Tea

This roasted Japanese Bancha is wonderfully soothing and nutty with an almost caramel fragrance and flavour.

### Genmaicha Chi Chi

Our take on Genmaicha, this combination of Japanese and Chinese green teas with toasted rice is enhanced with ingredients that add a vanilla sweetness to the roasted flavour giving it a creamy popcorn taste and aroma.

### Gatsby's Caramate
