COVID-19 Expectations and Procedures



Disclaimers: As with many things during the Covid-19 pandemic, this information is subject to change and we will keep you updated with the latest recommendations and our efforts to keep you safe while with Peninsula Kayak Company (PKC).

What you can expect from us:

- Guides will don masks during check in and the paddle instruction.
- We will be taking out groups no more than 10 people* at a time and will practice social distancing while on the water.
- The paddles, life vests, and kayaks will be wiped down after each use, and disinfected each night in preparation for the following day.
- We will respect and apply social distancing practices during transportation to/from our launch spots as well.
- You will never be put in a tandem kayak with someone not in your group.
- Rentals equipment will be sanitized before and after each use.

*If you have a private group larger than 10 we can facilitate those requests.

What we expect from you:

If you're sick or have had contact with anybody who has Covid-19, please stay home and contact your health care professional. PKC will provide a full refund, and we can reschedule you, or your group if you are traveling with one.

Symptoms include, but not limited to: Cough - Fever/Chills - Shortness of breath - Sore throat - Loss of taste/smell - Muscle Aches

Always maintain 6 feet (2m) of separation between people not in your group, and please limit the amount of people in your group from entering the kayak shop at one time. Unless you are checking in for your tour, have questions for our staff, or browsing the merchandise we ask that you relax at our "beach area" adjacent to the shop. We also ask you follow strict hand hygiene, and sanitize your hands on the way in and out of the shop. This will not only keep you safe, but will also limit the chance you pass on any virus to others.

If there are any questions regarding our Covid-19 safety procedures please feel free to contact the shop prior to your arrival. We have formulated these procedures in accordance with the CDC recommendations, state regulations, Door County Public Health, and the Door County Medical Center.
