Alcohol Management Policy

This policy aims to provide a basis for the responsible management of alcohol by the *Emerald Football Netball Club*.

This policy applies to all members, administrators, officials, coaches, players, visitors and volunteers of the *Emerald Football Netball Club*.

This policy is effective from 1-1-2007.

Policy

- 1. **Emerald Football Netball Club** is committed to conduct all aspects of alcohol service in a professional and responsible manner, comply with all applicable laws and adhere to endorsed Liquor Service Codes of Practice.
- An appropriate liquor licence will be obtained when serving alcohol at any club function or event.
- 3. Non and low alcoholic alternative drinks will be provided at all times. Tap water will be provided free of charge from the bar.
- 4. Functions, events or promotions will not be conducted that encourage excessive alcohol consumption as an incentive to attract patrons. (ie: cheap drink promotions, drinking competitions and all-inclusive cover charges).
- 5. Alcohol or drink cards/vouchers will not be provided as player awards or prizes for raffles and fundraising.
- 6. **Emerald Football Netball Club** acknowledge that drunkenness, under-age drinking and alcoholism are serious social issues and therefore supports initiatives that assist in addressing and preventing these issues.

Policy Promotion

The *Emerald Football Netball Club* will promote the alcohol management policy by providing this policy to all members upon registration each year.

The **Emerald Football Netball Club** recognises the importance of educating members, particularly players in the benefits of implementing an alcohol management policy and will endeavour to provide information to assist this process.

Non-compliance Strategies

All *Emerald Football Netball Club* committee members will enforce the alcohol management policy and any non-compliance will be handled according to the following process;

- 1. Explanation of the policy to the person/people concerned, including identification of the section of policy not being complied with.
- 2. Continued non-compliance with the policy should be handled by at least two committee members, who will use their discretion as to the action taken, which will include asking the person/ people to leave the association/club facilities or function.

Policy Review

To ensure this policy continues to be relevant for *Emerald Football Netball Club* operation and that it reflects both community expectations and the provisions of the Liquor Control Reform Act, the policy will be reviewed two yearly.











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
