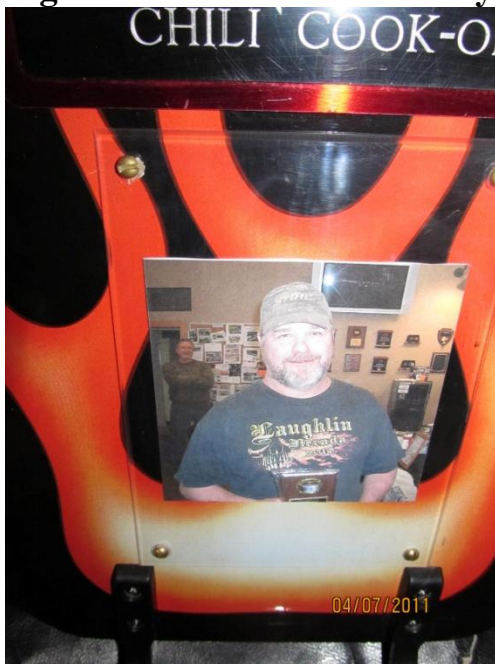
Chrissie M., Donna & I had dinner at the Racino last week. Someone in the group was a winner, but it wasn't Donna or I!

## Safety Officer; “Blurbs Blog”:

### Riding in the Dark:

Riding in the dark can pose its own set of problems for even the most experienced rider. You not only have limited sight distance but you have to contend with other vehicles blinding glare in your eyes and mirrors and also the factors of not being as visible as you are in daylight to them. Add to this that many of those other drivers on the road with you are on their cell phone, texting, feeling sleepy or perhaps have been drinking and it can get

dangerous very quickly.

If you wear eyeglasses, use a helmet face shield and/or have a windshield you should make sure all are clean and scratch free. This will greatly reduce glare and eye fatigue.

Be sure all the lights on your bike are in proper working order. If any of your bulbs don't seem “bright enough” it could be the lens has tilted to a less than desirable angle, so be sure to get that checked. Another option is to upgrade your light bulbs within specification of course for your bike.

There are many brighter bulbs available than the ones your bike may have come equipped with. Make sure to look at what your bike looks like lit from behind to vehicles following and if you find it lacking in visibility make some changes. You can also consider going to a dark parking lot and leaving your bike running and lights on, take a walk around at varying distance's and see what “you look like” in the darkness and make changes as you see needed.



You can add additional reflectors, reflective tape to clothing, helmet and even your motorcycle. Reflective tape comes in a variety of colors so that in daytime it may be hardly noticed. Also consider a high visibility vest or jacket with reflective qualities!

Always be sure to keep your speed proper for the distance you can see. Never over ride your headlight! When in doubt it is best to go slower leaving yourself greater reaction time to stop.

And finally be sure to dress properly for the evenings cooler temperatures and to always be aware that you share the darkness with many nocturnal animals such as deer.

Whenever possible it is best to travel in a group during dark hours. You present an overall larger area of lights so as to be more easily seen and also those several headlights give a better lighted area for safely traveling the roadways.

**You MUST be able to see and be seen to travel safely in the darkness!**

Just sharing some thoughts!


