## New Mileage Contest Rules

Last year, the club voted to change the rules for the mileage contest for 2020. Here is what you need to know:

- 1. All members, riders and passengers, who ride at least 1 mile are eligible to participate in the contest
- 2. You are automatically entered as long as your dues and National Membership is in good standing
- 3. You must have your mileage verified by an officer or road captain at least twice per year (once at the beginning of the season which starts with the first posted ride, and second at the end of the season which ends on Halloween)

It's that simple! No entry fee. Let's Ride!!

### Ride 365 Chapter Challenge 2019 Results are in...

There are two ways for a Chapter to win the Chapter Challenge.

- 1. Top Club Mileage Overall in your Market
- 2. Top Average Miles per member in your Market.

#### Our Chapter Stats are as follows:

- ♦ We reported 31 members riding an average of 3,356 miles each totaling 104,037 miles. We placed 28 in the Northeast Market.
- ♦ The winner in the Northeast Market was Ocean State Chapter Rhode Island with 146 members reporting an average of 2,778 miles for a total of 405, 602 miles!
- → Finger Lakes NY Chapter took the win for Average Miles per Member with 11 members reporting 6,888 miles per member for a total of 75,767 miles.

#### Other local stats:

- ♦ Albany -Schenectady Chapter NY reported 7 members riding an average of 3,522 miles for a total of 24,657 miles.
- ♦ Sacandaga Chapter Broadalbin NY did not participate.

## 2020 Ride 365 Challenge has started!

Ride 365 starts Jan 1 2020 and goes to Dec. 31, 2020. You can give your mileage to Alise McDermott at any time. Mileage will be verified by the dealership. You check in multiple times throughout the year but must check in at least twice to receive mileage credit.

Mileage is tracked by VIN number, therefore passengers will not receive credit. However, passengers tracking mileage through National HOG will continue to receive pins, patches and badges towards your lifetime recognition.
