Harley Davidson created HOG in 1983 to promote relationships with its riders, to provide a place for like minded enthusiasts to come together and enjoy the lifestyle.

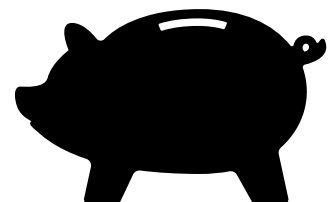

The road captains will be getting together before the February meeting to start putting the 2023 ride schedule together. Please let me know if you have any ideas for new rides.

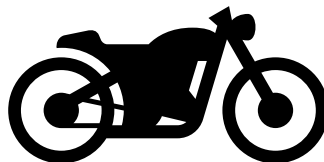
