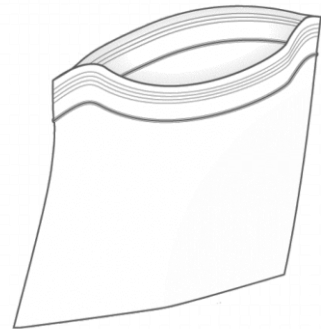

How To Make Ice Cream In A Zip bloc Bag

Small Batch

INGREDIENTS:

1 C half-and-half cream
2 tbsp granulated sugar
1/2 tsp pure vanilla extract
3 C ice
1/3 C kosher salt
Toppings of your choice



DIRECTIONS:

1. In a medium resealable freezer zip bloc bag, combine half-and-half, sugar, and vanilla. Push out excess air and seal.
2. Into a large resealable freezer Ziploc bag, combine ice and salt. Place the medium sealed Ziploc bag inside the bigger bag and seal. Shake vigorously, 7 to 10 minutes, until ice cream has hardened.
3. Remove from bag and enjoy with your favorite ice cream toppings.

Next time, try experimenting with different flavors including mint, maple, coconut and banana extract.
