- What happens on a very windy day?

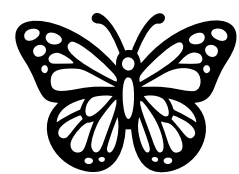
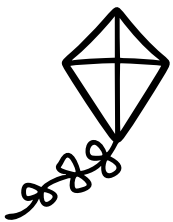
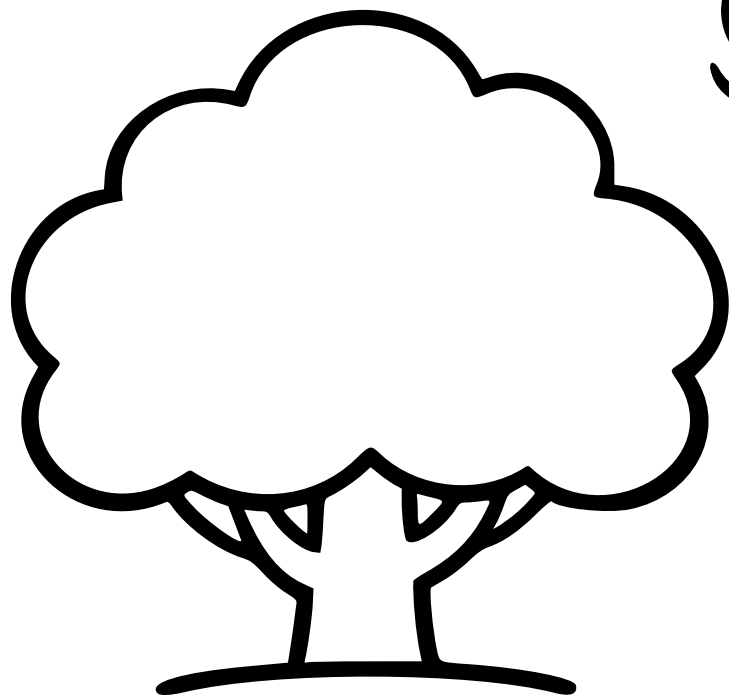
