

BELOVED WOMEN WALKING IN LIGHT 2024 EPHESIANS 5:1,8-9

Welcome to the "Beloved Women's Walking" program and resource. We are so humbled and grateful to have you here! Thank you! We count it a privilege that you chose to join us. We are seeking God the Father to help us imitate Him by walking as Light and in Light through Christ Jesus.

This resource was created in love, with you in mind. Prayer is so vital to the Christian walk. Christ has commanded us to "pray without ceasing". (1 Thess 5:17). Prayer is talking with God and communion with Him. This can take on various forms. We want to walk alongside and encourage you to be steadfast in prayer. We believe with all our hearts that our time this evening shouldn't just be a one time experience. We would love for **YOU** to be able to replicate the experience through repetitive reading of scripture, praying through music, and praying that scripture, in your own space, at your own pace. So, after much prayer, this tool has been tailored for just this purpose.

We recognize that some may have never prayed and worshiped in the style presented at BWW. Others may be eager to continue. You now have a tool that walks you through each step of adoration, confession, intercession, thanksgiving, and affirmation. Every section begins with scripture or a prayer. Sit and just read each verse or prayer slowly, with intention. Pause where you believe you should pause. Read it again, if necessary. Then pray where you pause. Ask God to speak to you in that pause. For example, in Adoration, start by asking God to reveal Himself fresh and/or clearly to you. Praise Him for Who He is. We believe Christian music and hymns are prayers set to music. Simply scan the QR code at the beginning of each section to view the playlist that correlates as you pray through that portion.

The great thing about using a tool like this for your prayer time is that you may choose to do only one part of the book or walk through the whole book in one setting. It's your choice. You can journal your prayers or just pray while listening to a worship song. It's your tool and you can use it as the Spirit leads. ENJOY!

Our prayer is that this booklet will be used to help grow and encourage your relationship with God the Father, through Jesus Christ our Lord in the power of His Spirit. May you have sweet communion with the Father. But, may it also aid in building you up in the Lord and His Body, the Church, for the sake of His Kingdom and His glory. May we know Him more and make Him known.

We humbly thank God for you and for the work He is doing. Amen!


A Simple Gospel Prayer
