Love:

God is eternally, infallibly effectual, enduringly love. He is compassionately loving. His love is true, steadfast and unbreakable. He makes and keeps covenant love in which He will not leave you nor forsake you.

This love is demonstrated through the sacrificial death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ for your sins.

Ephesians 2:4-6 ESV

But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved— and raised us up with Him and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,

1 John 4:7-12 ESV

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love. In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent His only Son into the world, so that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has ever seen God; if we love one another, God abides in us and His love is perfected in us.

Light:

God is righteous, good, and Holy. He cannot sin for there is nothing evil in him. He is luminary in every sense, being bright and clear (like lightning) but also including happiness and joy. His light exposes darkness/sin and is the light of men. Darkness can never overcome his light.



John 1:1-5 ESV

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him was not anything made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

1 John 1:5-7 ESV

This is the message we have heard from Him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with Him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Wise:

God possesses all knowledge, discernment, and understanding. He has infinite skill in insight, and in purity. He is just and good. He makes only right and excellent choices.



Isaiah 46:9-10 ESV

remember the former things of old; for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, "My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose,"

to the only wise God be glory forevermore through Jesus Christ! Amen.

Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God, be honour and glory forever and ever. Amen.

Gracious & Merciful:

God is kind and giving, full of compassion. He lavishes such unmeasurable, steadfast love by which He acts upon by giving freely a gift of favor that is undeserving and unmerited. Such grace and mercy keeps those in Christ from the wrath of God, which is deserving.



Exodus 34:6-7 ESV

The Lord passed before him and proclaimed, "The Lord, the Lord, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness, keeping steadfast love for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, but who will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children and the children's children, to the third and the fourth generation."

Psalm 145:8-9 ESV

The Lord is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. The Lord is good to all, and His mercy is over all that He has made.

Compassionate:

God is a God who has deep sympathy inwardly and deep pity. He acts and moves in love and kindness on behalf of those He pities.



2 Kings 13:23 ESV

But the Lord was gracious to them and had compassion on them, and He turned toward them, because of His covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not destroy them, nor has He cast them from His presence until now.

Mark 1:40-42 NASB

And a man with leprosy came to Jesus, imploring Him and kneeling down, and saying to Him, "If You are willing, You can make me clean." Moved with compassion, Jesus reached out with His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed." And immediately the leprosy left him, and he was cleansed.

All Powerful:

(Almighty, Omnipotent)

God's strength has no limits. He is sovereign and absolute ruler of all.

Sufficient:

God is self-sufficient and has no need of anything. Everything is His. He is the creator and maker of all things in Heaven and on Earth. But everything is dependent upon Him. He Himself is ample and enough to sustain life and meet needs. He is that which is necessary to live and live abundantly.

The Lord is my shepherd; I have what I need.

Ephesians 3:20-21 ESV

Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

2 Corinthians 3:5-6 ESV

Not that we are sufficient in ourselves to claim anything as coming from us, but our sufficiency is from God, 6 who has made us sufficient to be ministers of a new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit. For the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.

Immutable:

(Never changing)

God is always the same.

He doesn't change. He is
the same yesterday, today
and will be tomorrow.

He will never change in
nature, perfections,
purposes, promises,
or gifts.

Lord, you have been our dwelling place in all generations. Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

Hebrews 1:8, 10-12 ESV

But of the Son he says, "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, the scepter of uprightness is the scepter of Your kingdom. Savior:

Our soul waits for the Lord; he is our help and our shield. For our heart is glad in him, because we trust in his holy name. Let your steadfast love, O Lord, be upon us, even as we hope in you.

Romans 15:4, 13 ESV

For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.

Faithful:

God is trustworthy and to be believed. He gives assurance and is true in every sense of dependability. He is reliable. He never fails and is loyal. God is devoted to His purpose and plan.

God acts in kindness. The goodness of God is clearly seen through His redemptive plan by providing Salvation through Jesus Christ.

Kind:

God is benevolent, generous, and merciful. God's nature is giving and He acts in such a way that He does not withhold good. God is loving towards His creation. God has bowed Himself toward sinful mankind in such a way to reveal His love, mercy, and grace and to extend His covenantal love and salvation through Jesus Christ to all who will receive Him.
