

31st Annual Ride for Sight

It's that time of the year again as the Cheyenne Eye Clinic and Surgery Center/Cheyenne Sunrise Lions Club host the 31st Annual Ride for Sight on Sunday, Aug. 6.

The ride will consist of metric century (62 miles) or metric half-century (31 miles) distances although riders may opt to make their turn-around at any point they desire, but must start their return by 12 noon.

Sunday will open with a pre-packaged continental breakfast beginning at 6 a.m. with the start at 6:30 a.m.

Riders will find rest stops approximately every 10 miles featuring drinks, fruit, pre-packaged snacks, and energy foods plus toilet facilities. The event concludes with a post-ride lunch in addition to the awarding of various door prizes. There's no need to hurry back for lunch as it will be available until the final rider has cleared the course. Even if you are running really late, we will package a meal for you!

The Ride for Sight is fully supported with sag wagons, roving mechanics and HAM radio assistance. Nobody gets left on the course, either, as we carefully patrol the route at the end of the day and monitor every rider.

The Ride for Sight will also feature a complimentary T-shirt, water bottle, meal tickets and merchandise prizes! Plus, we'll have our great raffle topped by a \$1,000 store credit at Rock on Wheels as well as second and third place store credits of \$650 and \$350. 
