Consultations are underway: The Select Standing Committee invited feedback from May 31–June 20, with recommendations posted this August.

Fiscal Pressures are Real

Fiscal pressures are real:

A projected \$10.9B deficit in 2025–26, provincial debt expected to hit \$155B by 2027–28, and new spending demands mean government is looking closely at valuefor-money proposals.

Spending Priorities are Shifting

Spending priorities are shifting: \$15.5B in capital projects and \$4B set aside for contingencies leave limited room for new asks—but strategic, well-framed proposals can still break through.
