

MINOXIDIL 10%/FINASTERIDE 0.1 % HAIR FOAM

INFORMATION SHEET [HAIR LOSS TREATMENT]

What is this medication used for?

This medication is used for the treatment of androgenetic alopecia (male or female pattern hair loss).

- Minoxidil stimulates hair growth by increasing blood flow to hair follicles.
- Finasteride reduces dihydrotestosterone (DHT), a hormone linked to hair loss.

This combination may be prescribed when other treatments have been ineffective or to enhance hair regrowth.

Where should I keep my medication?

Minoxidil 10%/Finasteride 0.1% Hair Foam should be stored at room temperature [15° - 30°C (59° - 86°F)].

- The Foamer should be kept out of direct sunlight and kept in a dry place.
- The medication should be discarded after its beyond use date.
- Do not refrigerate or freeze

What side effects may I notice from receiving this medication?

Common side effects may include scalp irritation (itching, redness, flaking), mild burning or stinging.

Less common side effects may include unwanted hair growth on face/body, rapid heartbeat, or sexual side effects.

Contact your provider immediately if you experience serious or unusual symptoms.

How should I use this medication?

- Apply once daily, or as directed.
- Use only on a dry scalp.
- Part hair to expose thinning areas.
- Apply prescribed amount of foam and massage gently into the scalp.
- Wash hands after application.
- Allow foam to dry completely before styling or going to bed.
- Continue use for best results; it may take 3 to 6 months to see improvement.
- Avoid contact with eyes, mouth, or other skin areas. Avoid contact to broken or irritated skin.
