Early childhood education

Early childhood education (VVE) is part of the educational disadvantage policy. The aim is to better prepare toddlers with a possible (language) delay, also known as 'target group children', for primary school and to ensure that preschoolers can go to group 3 without any delay.

The VVE is for children from 2,5 untill 4 years old.



Education of immigrants

4 − 6 yr

Start at a regular primary school, children receive support from the teacher in their own class.

6 - 12 yr

Children start at a special facility for children who do not yet master the Dutch language. In Hoofddorp this is the IKC Wereldwijs language school. Here, the Dutch language is learned in 1 year, with extra guidance. After 1 or a maximum of 2 years, children move on to regular primary school.


