

TAMAROA CEMETERY ASSOCIATION RULES AND REGULATIONS

BURIAL LOTS:

Lots may be purchased from the Cemetery Association in increments of one, two, or four graves at a price set by the Board of Trustees. Payment of lots will be made to the Board Treasurer and payments must be made in full before any interment on said lots, and no monuments or markers can be installed until lots are paid in full.

The purchaser will not use the purchased lot for any purpose but for the burial of the dead. The purchaser will not sell or transfer this lot to another person without notice and approval of the Association. The Association reserves the right to re-purchase the sold lot that the Association has not approved for sale or transfer.

Each descendant must have a gravesite and only one interment per gravesite is allowed without exception. Cremated ashes must have a gravesite and may not be added to existing occupied gravesites.

MARKERS AND MONUMENTS:

Each marker or monument must have an adequate concrete base of sufficient size and strength to prevent the monument from becoming unsafe or stable. The owners will be advised of such monuments and will be given ninety days to repair the same. If not repaired, the Board of Trustees reserves the right to order the repair of any unsafe or unsightly monuments at the owner's expense. The board reserves the right to remove any monument deemed unrepairable.

*In the new section of the cemetery, the north and northeast, only flat markers are permitted.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE:

The custodian is hereby given wide latitude to remove, or cause to be removed, any item which interferes with the efficient care of the cemetery. This includes, but is not limited to; any glass or metal items, plants (live or artificial) in an unsightly condition, any above ground planters, seats or benches, or any other offensive or unsightly items. Items not permitted will be removed.

Artificial Christmas flowers are to be removed by the second week of February. Easter lilies will be removed by the first week of August.

There is to be no in ground planting by anyone other than cemetery employees.

The Board of Trustees reserves the right to enact and revise the rules for the care and maintenance of the cemetery at any time.

Any owner who wishes to request a change or protest any action taken may do so at any regular meeting of the Association.

*On January 26, 2016 the Board voted to amend the rules to allow upright stones in the new part of the cemetery, beginning February 1, 2016. Flat stones may be replaced with upright stones, at the expense of the grave owner or family.
