



Dear Friends and Supporters,

Thank you for joining us for this evening's Gold Medal Award Dinner celebration.

Tonight, we recognize E-J Electric Installation Co. (1889) in celebrating 125 years of service and honor Tony Mann CEO, with our Gold Medal Award. The fourth-generation, family-owned business has upheld a reputation of unparalleled integrity, quality, service and innovation. E-J has remained one of the oldest privately held companies and one of the largest electrical contractors in the United States. Under Tony's leadership the New York based firm has a presence in five states including recent expansion into Arizona.

The Hundred Year Association was established in 1927 to preserve the history and promote the heritage of public and private organizations that have been in existence for a century or more. Our membership comprises the metropolitan area's most enduring professional, educational, religious and charitable establishments. We support activities that maintain the history of these organizations, as well as those that positively impact the city today.

The Gold Medal Award has been presented to remarkable leaders and contributors to the City of New York every year since 1930 (except during WWII) "in recognition of outstanding contributions to the City of New York." Notable past recipients include civic leaders including Robert Moses, E. Virgil Conway and Ray Kelly; four New York City Mayors; business leaders including John Cushman and Dominick Servedio; organizations such as the Actors Fund, JB&B, New York Building Congress, Port Authority of NY & NJ, Richmond County Savings Bank and Fordham University; and three generations of Rockefellers.

The Association is best known for its awards programs – a public/private partnership with the City of New York. Since 1958, it has recognized career municipal employees for dedication well beyond their job description, measurably improving efficiency and quality of service to New York City residents and workers, and for significantly enhancing the prestige of New York City in the eyes of the public. Since 1971, it has granted college scholarships based on academic excellence, community service and financial need. The Association has distributed more than \$1.7 million in awards.

With your support tonight, the Association can continue to recognize the founding of organizations that have contributed much to our great city for a century or more. Any association, corporation, partnership or individual proprietorship whose continuity in its own right, or as successor to an organization in business for over 100 years, is eligible for membership. Our celebration this evening features special guest speaker Carlo Scissura, Esq., President & CEO of the New York Building Congress (1920). This broad-based organization's members comprise of
