

The Dance Haven Recital & Dress Rehearsal Handout – Important Please Read. Any questions should be addressed immediately before the day of the event. Our Dress Rehearsal & Recital Is Located At Reading Memorial High School. 62 Oakland Rd, Reading MA.

Our Dress Rehearsal is on Saturday June 20, 2026. All Act 2 & 3 students arrive at 11:00 am to sign in and set up at the Back Stage entrance. All Act 1 Students arrive at 12:00 pm to sign in and will be helped back stage. We will start promptly at 12:30 pm. **NO ONE IS ALLOWED BACK STAGE UNLESS YOU ARE A STUDENT OR STAFF.** Only 1 parent per student is allowed in auditorium during Dress Rehearsal. Any young siblings are also welcome. Anyone else needs to come to recital day as we have an occupancy limit on this day. All students must be ready dressed in first costume with hair and makeup done. (Do the best you can for Dress Rehearsal.) Students should bring one bag with shoes and costumes. **No food or drink allowed back stage.** We will have water available to students. We are not responsible for items lost, so please no video games, cell phones, jewelry etc. Please come prepared as we will start promptly at 12:30 pm. Shoes and bags should be labeled with name or initials. **PLEASE NO FOOD BACK STAGE- WE CAN NOT MONITOR FOOD ALLERGIES!**

The show has 3 ACTS. A Show order is attached along with makeup and hair requirements. Students may sit in the audience with family in their reserved seat during ACTs they are not performing in. After students perform in their ACT they will take a bow and we will dismiss them from backstage. At the end of ACT 1 we will have a special presentation of awards. Students only in Act 1 can leave after the presentations. Students in ACT 2 & 3 Can leave after their last dance as we will do their special Finale before starting Act 2 just on Dress Rehearsal day. **You can take pictures or video during dress rehearsal but not recital we will have both a videographer and a photographer on Recital Day.**

Our Recital is on Sunday June 21, 2026 All Act 2 & 3 students arrive at 10:30 am to sign in and set up at the Back Stage entrance. All Act 1 Students only arrive at 11:15 am to sign in and will be helped back stage. **WE WILL OPEN OUR AUDITORIUM DOORS FOR GUESTS AT 11:30 AM. PERFORMANCE WILL BEGIN AT 12:00 PM.** **NO ONE IS ALLOWED BACK STAGE UNLESS YOU ARE A STUDENT OR STAFF** All students must be ready dressed in first costume with hair and makeup done. Students should bring one bag with shoes and costumes. **No food or drink allowed back stage.** We will have water available to students. We are not responsible for items lost, so please no video games, cell phones, jewelry etc. Please come prepared as we will start promptly at 12:00 pm. Shoes and bags should be labeled with name or initials. **PLEASE NO FOOD BACK STAGE – WE CAN NOT MONITOR FOOD ALLERGIES!**

The show has 3 ACTS. A Show order is attached along with makeup and hair requirements. ACT 1 only students will be dismissed from back stage after ACT 1 and can sit in the audience. All Act 2 & 3 Students will take a final bow at the end of Act 3.

NO flash photography or video recording is allowed during the recital performance. A professional videographer has been hired and digital downloads can be ordered through the link I have emailed to parents or the QR code during the recital. **Our Alumni Student Ceris Sperdelozzi will also be taking professional photos on recital day.**

- NO GUM CHEWING BACKSTAGE OR ON STAGE
- ALL STUDENTS MUST WEAR REQUIRED TIGHTS AND UNDERGARMENTS (TIGHTS ONLY IF THEY DO NOT HAVE A COSTUME CHANGE)
- ALL STUDENTS MUST ARRIVE ON TIME – WE WILL NOT WAIT TO START AS WE HAVE TO ADHERE TO THE RENTAL TIME SLOT
- ALL STUDENTS MUST WEAR REQUIRED HAIR STYLE AND MAKE UP
- NO ONE IS ALLOWED BACKSTAGE UNLESS YOU ARE A STUDENT OR STAFF
- NO SMOKING ON SCHOOL PROPERTY
- NO LATEX BALLOONS ALLOWED PER RULES OF THE FACILITY
- NO FOOD ALLOWED BACK STAGE OR IN THE AUDITORIUM
- PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS WITH STUDENTS NAMES
- PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IN THE MIDDLE OF A DANCE ROUTINE AS IT IS A DISTRACTION FOR OTHERS IN THE AUDIENCE
- APPLAUSE IS WELCOME BEFORE AND AFTER ROUTINES

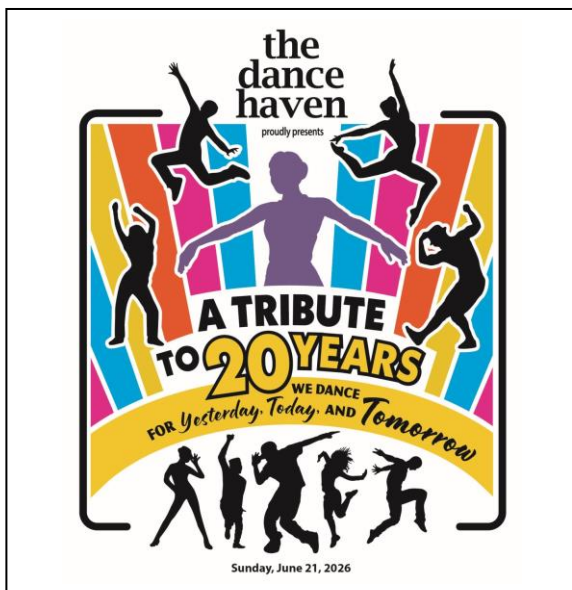

The Dance Haven Recital Hair & Make Up requirements

A) Students ages 3-9 should have light make up & matte lip stick.

B) Ages 9 and up should use neutral palette that is darker than skin tone to enhance features so lights do not wash them out. Eyelashes look great for older students but not required. Red Matte Lipstick, Gloss gets on Costumes!

All students must arrive to RECITAL with hair & make up already done.

Hair Requirements By Age/Class:

- Tuesday & Saturday Ages 3-5 - Hair Up off face a bun or braids is nice if hair is long enough.
- Saturday Ages 5-7 Up Off Face Bun or Braids is recommended.
- All Other Age Groups & Classes Two French Braids with low bun see picture

NOTE: Do not add your own hair accessories; all students will have matching ones if required.
