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THIS IS GOOD FOR WASH CLOTHS

SUPPLIES

- for dish cloth use 1 (50 gr) ball of scrubby yarn for 2 (6" sqs) and 4mm hook
- for face wash cloth use any soft cotton yarn and appropriate hook for yarn weight



STITCHES in USA TERMS

ss - slip stitch hdc - half double crochet ch – chain beg - beginning " - inch sq - square

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. ch 4, 3hdc in beg ch, turn (place marker in beg ch)
- 2. ch 4, (place marker around ch 4 just made), 3hdc in last 3 chains
- 3. ss into 1st ch sp of 1st block, ch2, 3hdc in this ch sp (place marker in ch 2 sp), Turn.

NOTE: IT IS HELPFUL TO PLACE A MARKER IN EACH CH 2 (or ch1) space

- 4. ch 4, (place marker in ch sp), 3hdc in next 3chs,
- **5**. Repeat across to end of row : (ss in next ch 2 sp, ch2, 3hdc in same ch 2 sp). Turn at end of row.
- **6**. ch 4, sk 1 ch, hdc in each of next 3 ch.
- **7.** Repeat steps 5 and 6 until your desired width (I made 6"-7" sq for dish cloth and 10"-12" sq for face wash cloth)

YOU NOW HAVE A (6-12") RIGHT ANGLE TRIANGLE EACH FOLLOWING ROW NEEDS TO DECREASE 1 BLOCK ON EACH SIDE

- 1. slip stitch across the 1st block (3 ss)
- 2. ss into the next ch3 space and complete a block (3hdc)

FOR C2C RECTANGLE

When desired width is reached, decrease one side and continue increasing other side until desired length is reached



- 3. complete the row as in step 5, turn
- 4. Repeat row 1 of decrease
- 5. Repeat decrease rows 3 and 4 until there are no more blocks to work

FINISH OFF

To make a hanging loop, sc foundation ch 7 (or as desired) and ss into corner fasten off and weave in ends
