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### **CHEVRON PULLOVER**

Mla design based on Make My Day Creative 3 season sweater

#### **SUPPLIES**

Hooks: 6.0mm, 5.5mm, 5.0mm, 4.5mm WT #3-#4 yarn, about 300 grams

I used 2 colors: A-orange for the main sweater and B-blue for the trim around neck, sleeves, hem

The sweater is worked in the round from the top down, turning the work after the completion of each round.

#### **SIZES**

Sizes: 33, 36, 39, 42, 45, 48 inch bust

#### **USA ABBREVIATIONS**

scfch – single crochet foundation chain hdc – half double crochet st(s) - stitch (es) sk – skip sl-st -slip stitch ch – chain

dc – double crochet

hk – hook tog – together

ch sp – chain space

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

### BODICE


COLOR A: Begin at neckline with a 5.0mm hook. Scfch 100.

**Round 1**: ch3 (counts as hdc+2ch), \*hdc, hdc, sk-st, hdc, hdc, ch2, repeat from \* around, hdc, hdc, sk-st, hdc, join with a sl-st (do not turn work) (90, 96, 102, 108, 114, 120, sts) JOIN TO MAKE CIRCLE. TURN.

Round 2: ch3 (counts as a dc), (dc, ch2,2dc) into ch-sp, dc, sk 2 sts, dc, (dc, ch2, dc) into ch-sp, dc, sk 2 sts, dc, \*(2dc,ch2,2dc) into ch sp, dc, sk 2 sts, dc, (dc, ch2,dc) into ch sp, dc, sk 2 sts, dc, repeat from \* around, join with a sl-st into starting chain, turn. (105, 112, 119, 126, 133, 140 sts)

**Round 3**: ch 3 (counts as a dc), \*sk 2 sts, dc, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) into ch sp, dc, sk 2 sts, 2dc, (dc, ch2,dc) into ch sp, 2dc, rep from \* around omitting last dc, sl-st into 1 st ch to join, 2 sl sts. ch3, turn. (120, 128, 136, 144, 152, 160 sts)





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**Round 4**: \*sk 2 sts, 2dc, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) into ch sp, 2dc, sk2 sts, 2dc, (dc, ch2, dc) into ch sp, 2dc, repeat from \* around, join into last ch of row 3, turn. (135, 144, 153, 162, 171, 180 sts)

**Round 5:** sl-st, ch 3, dc, \*(2dc, ch2, 2dc) into ch sp, 2dc, sk2 sts, 3 dc, (dc, ch 2 dc) into ch sp, 3dc, sk 2 sts, 2dc, repeat from \* around omitting last 2 dc, join with a sl-st, sl- st, turn (150, 160, 170, 180, 190, 200 sts)

**Round 6:** ch3, \*sk 2 sts, 3 dc, (dc, ch2, dc) into ch sp, 3dc, repeat from \* around, join with a sl-st into starting ch, sl st, turn (150, 160, 170, 180, 190, 200 sts)

R7-: 5.5mm hk; REPEAT R6: \*sk 2 sts, 3 dc, (dc, ch2, dc) into ch sp, 3dc, repeat from \*

**R8-R16: 6mm hk;** REPEAT R 6 UNTIL PIECE MEASURES 12" FROM NECKLINE TO LOWER EDGE;

\*sk 2 sts, 3 dc, (dc, ch2, dc) into ch sp, 3dc, repeat from \* . **FASTEN OFF.** 

#### **NECKBAND**

With color B and 4.5mm hook, attach yarn to center back at top; follow round 1, join, turn .

The goal is to reduce and raise the broad boat-neck from 18" to 9" wide when folded.

- 1. ch3/dc, dc in next st, sk 2sts, dc in next st, (dc,ch2,dc) in ch2 sp, dc in next st, join, turn
- 2. ch3/dc, sk3, dc, \*(dc, ch2,dc) in ch2, dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> dc, (dc, ch2,dc) in ch 2 sp, dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> dc, (dc,ch2,dc) in ch2 sp \* end round with dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> dc, sl st to next st(base of turning ch),turn Neckline now measures 12"wide.
- **3**. ch3/dc, dc, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch2 sp, \*( 2sctog, skipping over 1 st), (dc,ch2,dc) in ch2 sp\* **2sctog:** insert hook in st & pull thru, sk next st, insert hook in 3rd st, yarn over, pull through 2loops, yo, pull through 2 loops.

Fasten off.

#### MARK ARM HOLES and SLEEVE PLACEMENTS

- Lay flat and folded in half,
- Pin center st of each side under arms
- This should be round 18
- There are 3 points & valleys at under arms; There are 4 points across body;
- Pin valley for center of under arm
- Pin points on each side of center pin under arm
- [dc, sk 2 sts, dc= valley]



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• [(dc, ch2, dc) into ch sp=point]

#### ATTACH YARN after (dc, sk2, dc) BEFORE the 1st of 3 points under arm

- **1.**Begin sc foundation chain in the 2<sup>nd</sup> dc of (dc, sk2, dc) \*\*scfch6.
- 2. Attach foundation chain with sc to dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> dc of (dc, ch2, dc) after 3<sup>rd</sup> point under arm
- **3**.Continue in pattern: ch2,\* 3dc, sk2,3dc, (dc,ch2,dc) in ch2, 3dc,sk2,3dc\* to other under arm pin, repeat \*\* sleeve ch (**1. &2.**)
- **4.**Continue pattern around to turning ch; sl st to turning chain, turn and Continue body for anther 11"/18R
- **5.**Turn after each round.

#### **BODY**

- CONTINUE with 6mm hook in round 6 pattern:
- ch3, \*sk 2 sts, 3 dc, (dc, ch2, dc) into ch sp, 3dc, repeat from \*
- Work in pattern, continue in pattern across scfchs,
- continue working body until desired length, (18r/11) remember to turn each round.

**Round 10: increase** at center of each under arm valley (the dc-sk1-dc) work 4 dc instead of 3, ie. 2dc in 1 dc; for 4 rounds.

Round 15-: inc as in round 4, 3dc, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) 3dc; (dc, ch2,dc), slst, turn

Round 16: \*4dc,(2dc,ch2,2dc) in ch2 sp, 4dc, sk 2; 3dc, (1dc,ch2,1dc) in ch2 sp, 3dc; sk2\*

Round17: \*4dc,(1dc,ch2,1dc)in ch 2sp,4dc; sk2; 4dc( 1dc,ch2,1dc) in ch2 sp \*

**Round 18:** 4dc,(**2dc,ch2,2dc**) in ch 2 sp; 4dc sk2

FASTEN OFF COLOR A.

**ROUNDS 19-20:** ATTACH COLOR B; continue R18 pattern. FINISH OFF.

#### **SLEEVES**

Attach color A yarn to center st of under arm chain, continuing R6 pattern around shoulder. 7 points & 7 valleys

#### Work 11 rounds with 6mm hook:

R1: ch3/1dc, 3dc,sk2,3dc,\*(dc,ch2,dc) in ch2 sp, 3dc,sk2,3dc\*; sk2, 2dc, (1dc,ch1,1dc) in ch sp; 2dc, sk2, dc in in beginning dc st,turn.. dec made at under arm.

**R2:** Sk1dc,2dctog,1dc,sk2, **dec made \***3dc,(dc,ch2,dc) in ch2 sp; 2dc, 2dctog, sk2,join in top of turning ch/3dc. Turn. **Reduce to 5 points.** 

R3: sk1dc,3dc, \*(dc,ch2,dc) in ch 2 sp; 3dc,sk2,3dc\*; end with 2dc,2dctog, sk2, 2dctog, ch1, turn. 5 points.

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R4: sk 1<sup>st</sup> st, 3dc, \*(dc,2ch,dc) in ch2 sp; 3dc,sk2,3dc \*end with sk2 dc, turn

R5-: repeat R4, ending with 2dc, join to beg dc, turn

**R6-20: repeat R4: sk 1dc,** 3dc, \* (dc,ch2,dc) in ch2 sp; 3dc, sk2,3dc \*

#### **TRIM**

#### **BOTTOM HEM**

#### Attach color B with 6mm hook

**R1-3:** work 3 rounds as in last round of stitch pattern for body **R4:** Change to 4.5mm hook and work 1 round in pattern with sc **Fasten off.** 

#### **SLEEVE ENDS**

#### Attach color B

R1: work pattern with 6mm hook

[ \*3dc,(1dc,ch2,1dc) in ch2 sp, 3dc, sk2,\*]

**R2:** work pattern with **5mm** hook

R3-4-5: work in pattern with 4.5mm hook

R6-7-8-9: work in pattern with 3.5mm hook

Fasten off.
