


# Size a Hat for Anyone!



You just need to do some light math!  
You will need a **measuring tape**.

## Words to know:

- Head Circumference= the distance around the head.
- Diameter: the straight line passing from side to side through the center of a circle in this case the center of the crown portion

Things you need to know:

How to crochet in the round.

The trick to increasing in the round.

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Formula to find hat diameter:

$$\text{Head Circumference} / 3.14 = \text{Hat diameter}$$

( / represents the division sign)

Example:

$$23\text{in} / 3.14 = 7.32\text{in}$$

$$13.5\text{in} / 3.14 = 4.3\text{in}$$

Find the hat's length from crown to ear using the head circumference.

Formula to find hat length:

$$\text{Head circumference} * 4 / 10 = \text{hat length}$$

( \* represents the multiplication sign)

Example:

$$23\text{in} * 4 / 10 = 9.2\text{in}$$

$$13.5 * 4 / 10 = 5.4\text{in}$$

Use the measuring tape to measure your circle to confirm you have the correct diameter.

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
