Waist	24	Hooks	K-6.5mm; 5.5mm; 4.5mm
Hips	34	Gauge	10 sc X 10 rows=4"X4"
Back Waist Length	14 1/2	Buttons	6 (1")

ch – chain

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

ltc – linked treble crochet

inc – increase

dec - decrease

hdc – half double crochet

fp – front post

bp – back post

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## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

### **Body**

With hook K Chain 46, hdc across = 20 "(head circumference)
Divide evenly into 4 corners- 5" for back, 5 "for each shoulder. 2.5" for each front sc across 6 chains, 3sc in 7<sup>th</sup> chain and mark center stitch; sc across next 10 chains, 3sc in 11<sup>th</sup> ch, mark center st; sc across next 10 chains, 3sc in 11<sup>th</sup> ch, mark center stitch; sc across next 10 chains, 3 sc in 11<sup>th</sup> chain, mark center stitch; sc across last 6 chains, ch 1 and turn.

54sc at completion of row 1

## Begin pattern stitch

Linked Treble Crochet across on right side of fabric Half Double Crochet return row on back side of fabric

Increase corners with 3 corner stitches every row-2" increase every row When front and back equal chest measurement -about 5 rows

Chain 4 for underarm and attach to back and continue in pattern for desired length

#### Sleeves

Work in pattern around armhole for desired length- about 17" mark center of underarm, join each round to keep seam centered Decreasing every other row at end when joining (dec on hdc rows) With **5.5mm hook** Work 2" ribbing around sleeves with (2FPdc and 2BPdc)

#### Hood

Attach yarn to front shoulder corner and continue in pattern to opposite front shoulder corner

Continue in pattern until piece measures about 15 "

## **Edging**

With **5.5mm hook** Work 2" of ribbing all around Begin at lower right front Increase 3 sts at center fronts
Decrease over 3 sts at hood joinings

**Make Buttonholes** with **4.4mm hook** on left side with 3 chains on the 3rd row, **sc this** row and row 4 with 5.5mm hook, on  $4^{th}$  row, work over buttonhole chains; sew buttons on right side.
