



CHEVRON LACE PULLOVER

AN MLA DESIGN 3/5/2025

TOP DOWN CONSTRUCTION

SUPPLIES

- dk wt #3 yarn , 5 balls Love Crafts Paint Box Yarn Baby DK, 45% acrylic & 55% nylon, 182 yards/50 grams
- hooks 5.5mm & 5mm

GAUGE

multiple of 22 stitches
 1 chevron pattern = 2 inches
 1 double crochet = 1 inch tall

SIZE: 42" Bust, change size by changing hook size

US TERMS

fnd ch – foundation chain
 fnd sc – foundation single crochet
 sc – single crochet
 dc – double crochet
 ch – chain
 ch sp – chain space
 chevron – [2dc – ch 2 – 2dc] in ch 2 space
 sk – skip
 ss – slip stitch
 beg – beginning
 CB – center back
 CF – center front
 T – total

 prev – previous

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. With 5.5 mm hook** Foundation sc 50, join into a circle
- 2. * hd-ch2-hd, sk 1*** along ch
- 3.** ch2, 2 dc in 1st st, * 2dc – ch2 – 2dc* in ch sp, sk 2 sts, repeat along round. [18 completed chevrons], dc in next ch, join to beg ch 3 [this makes 2dc-ch2-2dc in beg ch] [T19 chevrons]
- 4.** [ch3, dc, ch2, 2dc] in beg ch sp, sk 1 st, 2 dc in next st (between 2 dc of prev rnd in ch 1) sk over 2 sts; chevron in ch 2 sp [2dc-ch2-2dc], sk1 st, 2 dc in top of 2 dc of prev rnd, sk 2 sts, chevron in ch 2 sp; ch to top of beg ch 3.
- 5.** chevron in ch 2 sp, dc in next 2 sts, sk 2 sts, dc in next st, chevron in ch 2 sp at end, sl st to join in beg ch3.
- 6.** 2dc in 1st st, 1 dc in next st, * chevron in ch 2 sp, dc in next 3 sts, sk 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, chevron in ch2 sp* to end of rnd. **End ball 1**



7. BEGIN ball 2; piece measures 5" long from neck and 44" circumference
The pattern is established with 8 total chevrons across front and 8 total chevrons across back + 1 chevron in CB; when folded CB POINT matches up with CF VALLEY.

7-12. Try on for armhole fit.

13. Finishes the yoke section and ball 2/190 yards used. At 3rd point from CB, (2dc in ch 2 sp), fnd ch 12 for about 4", [**joining chain**] [joins front to back at underarms], sk 1 chevron point, and join to 4th point. Continue in pattern around front to 3rd point from CF VALLEY, (2dc in ch 2 sp), fnd ch 12/4" and join to 4th point.

14. Change to 5mm hook and continue in pattern for body rounds.

Note: at joining chains – at last chevron, sk 2 dc, dc in next 3 sts, sk 1 st; in fnd ch: 2dc in next fnd ch, ch2, 2dc in next fnd ch, sk1 fnd ch, dc in next 3 fnd chs, sk 2 fnd chs, 2 dc in next fnd ch (the last fnd ch st); in body: dc in 1st body st after fnd ch, dc in next 2 st (3dc) (make sure to have 3 dc between chevrons) sk 2sts, dc in next 3 sts, continue in pattern [in ch 2 sp 2dc-ch2-2dc]

at next armhole chain, end of fndch12: in 1st fnd ch [2dc-ch2-2dc], dc in next 3 fnd chs, sk 2 sts, dc in next 3 fnd chs, in next fnd ch [2dc-ch2-2dc], dc in next 3 fnd chs.

End of fnd ch 12. DC in next of 2 st of body, in ch 2 sp [2dc-ch2-2dc] and continue pattern in rounds until desired length.

15-34. Continue in pattern for 22" total length from shoulder.

FINISHING

armholes: try on for fit. If too loose or low, mark cf & cb of armholes, attach yarn to cb in valley between chevrons and work a pattern row to cf marker in valley between chevrons, ss & turn, [dc 2 tog in next 2 sts] [1 dc in chevron ch sp] along towards back marker, skipping valley chains, at marker, hdc, sc ss, turn and sc all around armhole; fasten off securely. [pattern may not match up exactly with body, just count the stitches as was done in the beginning chain]

neckline: beginning at CB, evenly sc all around and ss to beginning st, fasten off securely.
