ELIGIBILITY

- To be eligible for the Transitional Housing Program, mothers must:
- Follow house rules
- Be first-time mother
- Be second trimester of pregnancy
- Be respectful and open to change
- Have Badger Care State Insurance
- Attend all educational classes





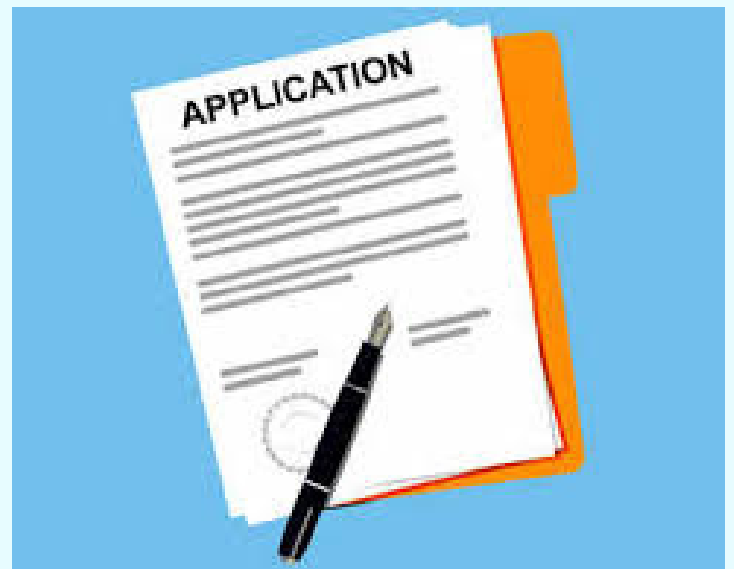
REFERRALS

All applicants will be screened through our referral agencies. When the applicant passes the screening process and referred to House of Hope MKE, an interview will be scheduled for possible placement . At that time, it will be determined if the Initial Intake should take place.
