### **Directions to Range**

From the Northeast side of town, take IH-35 south past the southwest side of 1604. Exit right onto Shepard Rd. As you drive on Shepard Rd. you will cross Pearsall Rd. keep going until you reach Jarratt Rd. Turn left and go until you reach the bend in the road. Just past the bend in the road is a Sign for Blackhawk Range. Turn right on the dirt road and go approximately .5 miles to the range entrance. From the Northwest side of town, take 1604 south, exit onto IH35 south, then exit onto Shepard Rd. The rest of the directions are same as above. Take a left at range house and follow dirt road to the range with a metal roof. On match days it is not necessary to check in at desk. All other days check in at range desk.
