

# NRA Regional Smallbore Rifle Championship



# 2400 PRONE & F-CLASS RIFLE TOURNAMENT MAY 3RD & 4<sup>TH</sup> 2025

**HOSTED BY:** South Texas Marksmanship Training Center (STMTC) & Blackhawk Shooting Range

**LOCATION:** This competition is held on the *Blackhawk Shooting Range*. Exit IH-35, Shepard Rd. As you drive on Shepard Rd. you will cross Pearsall Rd. Keep going until you reach Jarratt Rd. Turn left and go until you reach the bend in the road. Just past the bend is a sign for Blackhawk Range. Turn right on the dirt road and go approximately .5 miles to the range entrance.

**ADDRESS:** 12135 Jarratt Road

**ELIGIBILITY:** This event is open to all members and non-members of the NRA and STMTC. Must be a member of the NRA to establish a National Record.

**NRA RULES:** Will govern the tournament using rifle rule 3.2. Range Commands will be strictly enforced. Loading before the command "Load", Firing before the command "Commence Fire", and firing after the command "Cease Fire" are grounds for Disqualification. Eye protection, ear protection & "OPEN Bolt Indicators" are required.

**ENTRY FEES:** \$25.00 for one day. & 50.00 for Both. All Junior entries fees are 15.00 for one day and 30.00 for both. NRA registration and cost of targets is included. Entry fee will be refunded if competitor is unable to attend the tournament.

**REGISTRATION:** We are limited to 15 firing points. Range capacity is 30 in 2 relays. Walk on entries may be accepted to capacity of the range. Advanced Entry is highly encouraged, please register in advance by visiting PractiScore at:

**CLASSIFICATION:** NRA Classification will be used. Competitors will use their assigned classification. Those without a current NRA Smallbore classification may: (1) Use a temporary score book or (2) Compete in the Master classification; (NRA Rule 19.8) A competitor may shoot in a higher class.

**TOURNAMENT RESULTS:** Results will be posted on the website www.STMTC.org

**CHALLENGE FEES:** \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge of your own match score. \$3.00 for another competitors' match score. Fee returned for sustained challenges (NRA rule 16). Challenge slips provided by STAT official.

**PRONE; TARGETS:** NRA Conventional targets A23, A-25, and A-27 will be used. Competitors will hang their own target <u>and retrieve the target to their right</u>. Competitors may not handle their own fired targets anywhere at any time. **DO NOT SCORE YOUR TARGETS**.

**F-CLASS; TARGETS:** NRA Metric targets A51, and A33 will be used. Competitors will hang their own target and retrieve the target to their right. Competitors may not handle their own fired targets anywhere at any time. **DO NOT SCORE YOUR TARGETS**.

# Match 9 - South Texas Regional Championship, Aggregate Matches 4 & 8

**TIME:** Please try to arrive between 8:00 and 8:30am. This allows time for proper squadding and setting up of the range before the competition starts at 9 am. All shooting should be concluded at approximately 3 pm. Target assignment may be set ahead of time.

**AWARDS:** Awards will be given for each Aggregate match. The match 9 winner will receive a GOLD medal. The second and third place champions will receive SILVER and BRONZE medals respectively. Competitors that shoot a "Clean" target (200pts) will be awarded the STMTC Marksmen Pin, limit 1 Per person per Championship.

**INTENT & SPIRIT:** Smallbore Rifle shooting is a widely practiced sport intended for both juniors and adults. **The Intent & Spirit** of Smallbore rifle training is to promote target competitions with .22 caliber rimfire rifles. We encourage the use of rifles & ammunition that are relatively low-cost, readily available, and typically used during recreational target shooting. Any firearm or item of equipment that is not mentioned in the CMP/NRA rules or that is contrary to the intent and spirit of the rules is subject to the determination of the Match Director.
