- 2. All customers are required to complete this registration form for LRRC records <u>before</u> any repairs can be contemplated. A separate registration form must be completed for each item in a different category. LRRC is GDPR compliant and all information provided is treated with the utmost confidence and never passed to a third party. - 3. Customers are expected to remain with the repairer while the repair is being carried out in order to see how the repair is being done and to learn new skills. Items should not be left with the repairer and collected later but should the repairer offer to complete a repair at home, neither the repairer nor LRRC can assume any responsibility for the item's safe-keeping. The repairer and customer must exchange contact details and the customer is responsible for collecting the repaired item from the repairer.
- 4. Neither the organisers of LRRC nor the repairersin personal capacities or otherwise are liable for any loss or injurywhatsoever that may result from any repair carried out or for any advice or instructions given and used at a later date.
- 5. Neither the organisers of LRRC nor the repairers in personal capacities or otherwise are liable for any accidental damage that may occur to either visitors' goods (including vehicles parked at owners' risk in the Lyme Regis car parks) or personal effects during visitors' time at the sessions.
