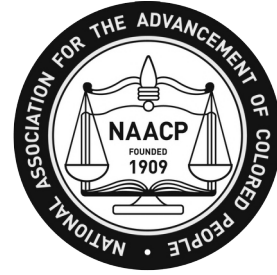


**Resolution of Respect
