He came Riding on a Young Donkey



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He entered Jerusalem riding on a young donkey that had never been ridden before. In doing so, he enacted the unfolding of the kingdom of God that would rise into a glorious, mighty kingdom through lowliness and suffering.

But—the naive people of Judah and Israel rejected a kingdom built on lowliness and suffering; they wanted to use force through military and economic strength to crush and humiliate their opposition. The house of Judah went to war against the Romans in 70 A.D. and lost. The redeemed house of Israel went to war during the Crusades and achieved very little. Both houses sought to establish the kingdom of God through military might; both houses failed.

"Not by might nor by power, **but by my Spirit**" (Zechariah 4:6) will the kingdom of God be established.

When will the covenant people of God who love striving for power and control understand that only through humility and peace, will the kingdom of God be established?

It will all become evident when Satan is thrown down to earth; when he knows that his time is short. He and his coalition will come out of the shadows; the world will see with their own eyes the dark forces of the heavens that have been playing them.

"For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the RULERS, against the AUTHORITIES, against the COSMIC POWERS over this present darkness, against the SPIRITUAL FORCES of evil in the heavenly places" (Ephesians 6:12).

Within the nations of Israel, a remnant has remained faithful throughout the ages into this present day and in the future, during these final days of this evil age. Satan and all of the rogue heavenly rulers detest their loyalty and love for God and they will turn on these saints with a vengeance in the latter day. A revival of the **pure** word of God will ignite, during their time of trouble. Their witness will awaken many in the nations of Israel and around the world.

They will rule the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod with drawn sword. **HE WILL DELIVER US FROM THE ASSYRIAN WHEN HE INVADES OUR LAND AND MARCHES INTO OUR BORDERS"** (Micah 5:5-6).

"In that day the remnant left in Israel, the survivors in the house of Jacob, will no longer depend on allies who seek to destroy them. But THEY WILL FAITHFULLY TRUST THE LORD, THE HOLY ONE OF ISRAEL" (Isaiah 10:20).

Christ, King of kings and Lord of lords will return at the end of the Great Tribulation and resurrect and give eternal life to his saints, beginning first with those who are dead followed by the living. They will meet him in the air and stand with him to fight against the heavenly rulers, powers and authorities who have captured the nations of the earth and hold God's remnant covenant people in captivity.

She casts a magic spell over the nations, leading them astray (Revelation 18:23). But, her end will be swift; she will fall and the wealthy elite will weep.
