

There will be wars and rumors of wars,
but *do not be alarmed*



Jesus said that there will be wars and rumors of wars, even wars between nations and kingdoms, but the end is still to come. Into the 21st century, an age of deadly weapons, wars and rumors of wars could be alarming, but these wars will not bring the end of this evil age.

The disciples may have pondered what event could be so climatic that it would bring the end of this world. Jesus added that there will be famines and earthquakes, but that is only the beginning.

Mankind today would be disappointed with Jesus' response. 21st century weapons can destroy complete nations. Nations like feeling secure when they hold military and economic strength above other nations. Yet, Jesus did not prophecy a win through military might.

He said, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to everyone" (Mark 16:15).

His focus was his redemptive sacrifice that would pay the price for sin for all of mankind. This good news meant a second chance for all of mankind of eternal life through the Messiah. No longer was mankind doomed to die. Then, what must happen to overthrow the deep state, the cabal, the illuminati and the evil spirits puppeteering the leaders of the nations to bring an end to their evil reign?

"When do we get to use our backward-engineered alien, super-military weapons?" 21st century Christians watching current geo-political news may ask.

Jesus continued as if he couldn't read the minds of the disciples and the 21st century Christians who are aware and awake of the many attempts to silence the conspiracies. O king, it is because of this hope that the Jews are accusing me. Why should any of you consider it incredible that God raises from the dead?"** (Acts 26:6-8)

The promise the twelve tribes embraced was the resurrection into life eternal and made possible through Jesus, the Messiah. This belief was not limited to some of the tribes of Israel, but people within all of the twelve tribes. The Jews are part of the twelve tribes. While many rejected Jesus as the Messiah and the Son of God, there is a remnant of people from within the tribe of Judah, the Jews, who believe in the promise of eternal life through the redemptive sacrifice of the Messiah and that Jesus is the Son of God.

This group of believers from all twelve tribes of Israel adopted a name. The Apostle Paul said, "For the king knows about these matters, and I can speak freely to him. I am confident that none of this has escaped his notice, because it was not done in a corner. Do you believe the prophets, King Agrippa? I know that you believe."

"Then Agrippa said to Paul, 'Can you persuade me in such a short time to become a **Christian?**'" (Acts 26:26-28)

The Christian churches are the leaders supporting the doctrine of eternal life through the redemptive sacrifice of Jesus. They are people in the twelve tribes of Israel that Paul was referring to. They initiated the task of taking the gospel to the whole world and they will remain the leaders to finish it. They will be the central target of Satan's raging temper. The gift of eternal life was not Satan's vision for creation on earth.

When Jesus said that they will be hated by all nations, persecuted and some killed, he was not speaking of the Jews who rejected him. He was speaking to the Christians who have all accepted him as their Messiah. The Christian churches took the gospel of the kingdom to the whole world. No other faith has a Saviour who has died to save all of mankind.

Well and good, may be the response for many in the Christian nations because they will try to escape the opposition by denouncing their faith, as it means very little to them, anyway. And indeed, that reaction was prophesied to happen.

“Now the Spirit expressly states that **in later times** some will abandon the faith to follow deceitful spirits and the teachings of demons, influenced by the hypocrisy of liars, whose consciences are seared with a hot iron” (I Timothy 4:1).

Matthew 24:10 prophesies a great falling away from the faith during this time of intense persecution. “At that time many will fall away and will betray and hate one another, and many false prophets will arise and mislead many.”

The rise of Mystery Babylon will bring intense hatred of the Christian nations. The nations of the world will be swept into her arms because of her exotic technologies, healing sciences and alternative saviours. The faithful Christians will not denounce Jesus Christ as their Saviour and they will then learn that the task they accepted hundreds of years ago has not been completed. It is comprised of two witnesses:

Early church witness

1. Proclaim the good news of God’s kingdom to all people and nations.
2. All of mankind have been saved through Jesus’ redemptive sacrifice.
3. Eternal life is again a gift offered to repentant mankind.

End-time witness

1. The Antichrist is not mankind’s saviour.
2. The “little horn” of Daniel is not the Supreme God.
3. Jesus of Nazareth is the Son of God who came in the flesh and died for the sins of mankind.
4. Worship only the Supreme God.

In the details of the end-time prophecy written in Matthew 24, Jesus added the end-time component of taking the gospel to all the world. “And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world **as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come**” (Matthew 24:14).

The end-time witness by the Christians will be the absolute factual truth—a legal testimony—to all the nations on earth that they must repent and stop serving Satan and the beastly coalition. They must bend their knee to obey the Supreme God, their Creator and only through the redemptive sacrifice of Jesus Christ can they have eternal life. Satan, the beastly coalition, the Antichrist and the false prophet will generate a tsunami of hatred towards all Christians who obey God’s commandments and hold to the testimony of Jesus. These Christians will speak the truth to all nations and unveil the enemy of mankind who rule in chaos, tyranny, lies and deceit.

Persecution and hatred of the Christian nations and their death will continue until they complete the job that they accepted hundreds of years ago.

THE CHRISTIANS WILL ENTER A RELIGIOUS WAR FOR THREE AND A HALF YEARS

“And the dragon was enraged at the woman, and went to **make war with the rest of her children, who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus**” (Revelation 12:17).

Satan is enraged with the woman in Revelation—a church—and he will try to destroy her. She is a faithful body of men and women who are bound in a blood-covenant with Almighty God and His Son, Jesus Christ. These people will never defect because they love righteousness and hate wickedness. Her offspring are all of the Christian churches and Jewish synagogues. They all preach different doctrines. They will all be corrected by the two witnesses of Revelation. Their misunderstandings and misconceptions will be shown to them. They will need to overcome, if they want to be in God’s kingdom. They must keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus.

Satan is imaged as a fiery dragon with a long tail that has swept one-third of the angels in heaven into and under his rule.

THE TAIL, THE RELIGIOUS LEADERSHIP

The tail is symbolic of religious leadership. Ancient Israel became so corrupt and depraved that God had to purge all of their leaders—the head and the tail. “So **the LORD will cut off Israel’s head and tail**, both palm branch and reed in a single day. **The head is the elder** and honorable man, and the **tail is the prophet who teaches lies**” (Isaiah 9:14-15).

The head is representative of the honourable, knowledgeable, wise national leaders. The tail is representative of the God-fearing and God-serving righteous prophets, priests, and ministers. Unfortunately, during this evil age most national leaders are liars, deceivers and corrupt and many religious leaders are silent of the wrong-doing of their national leaders, mere followers of traditional teachings, slow to test and retest teachings and prohibited to think differently. Unity among the Christian churches has not been achieved. Satan’s work of confusion and discord is indeed active, but not unstoppable.

Satan disdains creation on earth because God Almighty has a purpose for them. They were created to become a kingdom of royal priests in His holy kingdom, experts in God’s theology of grace and love. Creation in heaven is a kingdom of ruling princes who are experts in God’s law.

Satan imaged as a fiery dragon, sweeping one-third of the angels in heaven into his kingdom with his tail, is an illustration of him preaching his theology and seducing a very large number of angels into his church.

Satan and his congregation believe they are fully qualified to be experts in both law and theology. They believe their law and theology can be married to work as one body. Their perversion of God’s law and strange religious rituals performed by these fallen angels and rebel sons of God become known to mortals who engage in Satan worship.

An entire race of people in South America came to an end through the ritualistic practice of human sacrifice performed in service to their gods. Without truth, mankind is easily tricked into believing blatant lies. Satan will stop at nothing. "In fact, **unless that time of calamity is shortened, not a single person will survive.** But it will be shortened for the sake of God's chosen ones" (Matthew 24:22).

When all of mankind realizes that Satan and the beastly coalition that arrive on earth desires to take their soul and subvert them so they are irredeemable, they will humbly repent. Those who do not repent will have given their soul away, knowingly, holding to the great lie that Satan and the beastly coalition actually care for them.

THE GOSPEL WILL BE PREACHED AS A WITNESS TO THE NATIONS

Christ fulfilled the requirement of the law by ensuring a testimony of two or more witnesses was provided to attest to his case in regard to his death, resurrection and ascension. This should have brought rest to the Jewish priests. "You must not convict anyone of a crime on the testimony of only one witness. **The facts of the case must be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses**" (Deuteronomy 19:15).

Many, many witnesses collectively have attested to the death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus, the Son of God.

Sleeping Christians will awaken in a fright when they realize that they should have been on watch. The parable of the ten virgins is the story of the Messianic Jews and Christians. A great number of them have fallen asleep. Geo-political events will awaken them during a time of great distress. Only 50% of them will be prepared to put their life on the line to ally with Almighty God and Jesus Christ. Spiritual rebels will be ruling over the nations on earth mandating the worship of Satan and the beastly coalition. The other 50% will be rattled. They live outside of God's theology and suddenly the great religious war on earth will open their eyes to only two choices: good or evil. They will run to the righteous 50% for help who will give directions, but there is not enough time for them to be ready spiritually. This group will be the easy target of the beastly coalition. An alien arrival on earth will instantly change everyday life. Supernatural events will disarm all of the nations.

"One of the heads of the beast appeared to be mortally wounded. But the mortal wound was healed, and **the whole world marveled and followed the beast. They worshiped the dragon who had given authority to the beast, and they worshiped the beast, saying, 'Who is like the beast, and who can wage war against it?'**" (Revelation 13:3-4)

The world will be in awe by what the beastly coalition can do. The mortal wound will be healed. They will witness a resurrection before their very eyes. It will stun them, impress them, and instantly weaken them. They will say, "Who has such power like this beastly coalition of seven great kingdoms with ten supernaturally powerful kings and their healing technology? We cannot go to war against this supernatural force, so we will surrender to save our lives."

One might ask, but what about the backward engineered stash of alien weapons and technology? Those having the highest Q level clearance and knowledge of these exotic weapons will still back down from what they will witness when the beastly coalition puts their power on display for all the world to see and shudder.

"Spare your people, O LORD. Do not make your inheritance an object of scorn, a byword among the nations. Why should they say among the peoples, 'Where is their God?'" (Joel 2:17b).

The LORD God is watching over His people in captivity and those under siege. He will allow this calamity to ignite spiritual growth and strength in His people who failed to grow previously. The people in the nations will mock God and His fallen people as if God has abandoned them. He has assured His people in this prophecy that never again will He make them an object of scorn to the nations. "I will drive the northern army far from you, pushing it into a parched and barren land" (Joel 2:19b-20a).

While in captivity, mocked, scorned and scattered among the nations, God's people will remember Him and ally with Him in righteousness. Those who made idols of these rebel sons of God will be ashamed.

At that time, God will plead with them. **"Return to the One against whom you have so blatantly rebelled, O children of Israel. For on that day, every one of you will reject the idols of silver and gold that your own hands have sinfully made"** (Isaiah 31:6-7).

God's people will preach the gospel of God's kingdom and the rewards God has for all of mankind. They will declare Jesus' redemptive sacrifice for all creation on earth and urge these people of the nations to worship only Almighty God. The worship of Satan and the beastly coalition and the making of idols will be recognized as treason, subject to God's law that brings death. They will witness the absolute truth, like the words spoken under an oath in the court room.

The people in the nations may initially be confused due to the dazzling supernatural abilities of the beastly coalition and the false prophet. God's people will not stop witnessing because they too, want to save all people everywhere.

The people of the nations must all hear their testimony, so that they are without excuse on the day of their judgement. The Christian nations who accepted the task to take the gospel to the whole world must finish it and they will.

The end cannot not come, until the gospel of the kingdom is preached in all the world **as a testimony to all nations** (Matthew 24:14). The sins that keep mankind from entering into life eternal in God's kingdom must be made fully known to them, and then, this evil age will come to a close.

The intensity of the great war during Jacob's trouble will take many lives. A remnant of God's people will survive and return home. "In that day **the remnant of Israel**, the survivors of the house of Jacob, **will no longer rely on him who struck them down** but will **truly rely on the LORD, the Holy One of Israel**. A remnant will return, a remnant of Jacob will return to the Mighty God. Though your people, O Israel, be like the sand by the sea, only a remnant will return" (Isaiah 10:20-22).

TAKEN CAPTIVE, LIVING THE FAITH

The Christian churches will demonstrate faith as many members will be taken captive by the beastly coalition.

The leaders over the nations will not bend, but the people will listen. During a time where alien gods wield uncontrolled power and mankind is at the mercy of a supernatural war machine, the people of the nations will waver. The Christian churches have nothing to lose.

TAKEN CAPTIVE, LIVING IN TRUTH

The Christian churches, by this time, will have listened very carefully to the two witnesses who preach the pure word of God. They will learn from them and see very clearly all of their misunderstandings, misconceptions and even disinformation from false ministers. Their nakedness

will be exposed to bring them into repentance to follow Jesus wherever he goes. In one voice, the Christian churches will oppose the “little horn.”

This will enrage the “little horn” who will turn on the holy angels within his reach and the saints of God. “He will destroy the mighty and the holy people” (Daniel 8:24b). The Christians will declare their allegiance to the Almighty God—the God of Israel and stand with Jesus of Nazareth, the Son of God and Messiah of mankind. In doing so, their witness will reach people in all nations everywhere as this religious war intensifies.

TAKEN CAPTIVE, LIVING IN REPENTANCE

In a vulnerable state, Christians will grow strong. As prophecy unfolds, they will recognize that they are on centre-stage. They will lament their previous lack of spiritual growth and acknowledge God’s way to bring them to their knees. In their renewed strength, they will oppose the great harlot, the false prophet and the Antichrist and expose their lies and deceit. They will not fear losing their lives.

At that time, the Jews who had rejected Christ will see their grave mistake and they will repent. Together with the Christians, they will return weeping before the LORD their God.

“‘In those days and at that time,’ declares the LORD, ‘the children of Israel and the children of Judah will come together, weeping as they come, and will seek the LORD their God’” (Jeremiah 50:4).

TAKEN CAPTIVE, LIVING IN PEACE

During their intense distress, the Christians will find peace because they will trust their God. They will put on the armour of God and live in truth, make and act on righteous decisions. Despite the chaos around them and instability, they will be ready to make peace with those who oppose and mock them through forgiveness of sins. Regardless of the insults and the abusive treatment, they will not lose faith in God’s promise of eternal life in His family. They will be prepared to die fighting to spread the truth about Almighty God, His grace and His love for all of mankind.

THE RELIGIOUS WAR WILL BE WON THROUGH THE OUTPOURING OF GOD’S HOLY SPIRIT

God will pour out His Holy Spirit on all people. He prophesied, “Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, and your young men will see visions. Even on servants both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days” (Joel 2:28-29).

People from the nations will repent and bend their knee to worship the Almighty God, their Creator. They will turn against Satan, the beastly coalition, the false prophet and the Antichrist. Military weapons will not be used to bring people into repentance. God’s Holy Spirit will awaken them to see the truth and turn to live righteously purging wickedness quickly and thoroughly.
