Hours of Operation:

You may tear down on Saturday at 5:00 PM (after we get our big "group" photo) or you may return Sunday morning. Fair warning, that is Mother's Day so clear it with all moms in your family so none of us get in trouble:)

All Volunteer Parking: For event days, we have the gracious use of parking at the Common Ground Church kitty corner from our event space. Park and simply cross the street.
