All BPAC staff has ultimate approval of complete dress code before dancers take the stage for any awards ceremony.



BPAC Dance Company Awards Ceremony Dress Code:

- Black leggings or black pants
- BPAC Competition Team T-Shirt
- **BPAC Competition Team Jacket**
- **Sneakers**
- Accessories are welcome, as long as they are neat and presentable
- Overall look should be clean, put-together and professional
- Only BPAC approved items are allowed on stage – approved props include pom-poms or other blue accessories used to celebrate BPAC.

Please Note:

Costumes are allowed to be worn on stage with your competition jacket zipped up over it if you have a dance right before or after awards.
