

# Pricing

## *Edge to Edge Pricing*

E2E pricing for all our patterns is \$0.02 (2 cents) per square inch.

FOR EXAMPLE:

If your quilt is 55 inches wide and 65 inches in length, multiply  $55 \times 65 = 3575$  then multiply this number by .02 = \$71.50

Plus, NC sales tax of 7.25%

$\$71.50 * .0725 = \$5.18$

$\$71.50 + \$5.18 = \$76.68$

We have a minimum charge of \$50 per quilt.

We do charge sales tax for NC customers.

All quilts are completed on a computerized and fully programmable Gammill Statler longarm quilting machine. We can re-size any pattern up to 24" to best fit your quilt pattern. We will adjust the size of the pattern to best fit your quilt.

## *Batting Prices*

We are happy to accept batting you supply for your quilt.

If you choose, we can supply batting at the rate of \$0.33 per linear inch.

We provide Hobbs Heirloom Premium 100% cotton batting.

Below is sample batting prices based on the size of your quilt. Always measure the longest edge to determine the length.

Type of Quilt	Size	Linear Inches	Cost per LI	Batting Cost
Baby	60 x 45	60	\$0.33	\$19.80
Twin	90 x 72	90	\$0.33	\$29.70
Full	96 x 90	96	\$0.33	\$31.68
Queen	108 x 90	108	\$0.33	\$35.64
King	124 x 120	124	\$0.33	\$40.92

## *Thread Type*

I use Omni Superior Thread in all my quilts. OMNI is a clean, bright, strong thread and is a favorite of many long arm quilters. It is a 40-wt. polyester thread that is designed to withstand the rigors of high-speed quilting.

We do not charge any extra for one thread color. Any additional color would be \$10.00 per color.

### *Preparing your Quilt*

Please have the backing of your quilt pieced, squared and add 4 extra inches on all 4 sides to allow my machine to safely quilt your top.

I will iron your top prior to quilting to ensure all fold lines are diminished because of shipping.
